First, check your grip. I couldn't see any knuckles on my left hand - classic weak grip. The pro had me rotate my left hand slightly right, feeling weirdly strong at first but man, what a difference.

My stance was a disaster too. Apparently I'd been aiming left subconsciously to compensate for my slice. Talk about making things worse!

The simulator was eye-opening. It showed my classic "over the top" move - coming outside-in like I was trying to chop wood, not hit a golf ball. The instant feedback let me feel the difference between my usual hack and a proper inside-out swing path.



I spent an hour hitting balls while focusing on closing the clubface through impact. Felt totally unnatural at first - I was convinced I'd hook everything left. But the ball flight doesn't lie. Straight as an arrow.

What's killer about Extreme Indoor Golf is seeing everything in real-time. No more guessing what went wrong. The data tells you exactly what's happening with clubface angle, swing path, all that technical stuff I used to ignore.

Listen, I dropped 5 strokes literally the next round after my session. Not kidding. Call them up and book some time. Their instructors don't overwhelm you with 20 swing thoughts - they find your one major issue and fix it. Worth every penny.

See you there - I'll be the guy smiling while hitting it straight down the middle for once!
