

## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. A current negative Coggins is required at the show office prior to receiving a back number.
2. Liberty Line Farm, employees, volunteers, and/or property owners will not be responsible for any accidents, loss or injury to any person, horse, or property incurred on any of the show grounds. Exhibitors are participating at their own risk.
3. The entry fee is \$25.00 per class unless otherwise stated.
4. Stake classes must have a minimum of six entries for payback. 50% of the stake classes entry fee will be paid back as 1<sup>st</sup>- 45%, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 30%, 3<sup>rd</sup> – 15%, 4<sup>th</sup> – 10%
5. Returned checks will be charged \$40.00.
6. There will be a \$20.00 Grounds/EMT Fee
7. Classes must have a minimum of three entries to compete
8. All riders must wear a properly fitted ASTM and SEI approved helmet with chinstrap secured while mounted on a horse anywhere on the grounds.
9. The judge's decision is final.
10. All dogs must be leashed while on the property.
11. All equine activities are pursuant to PA Equine Law Act 93 of 2005
12. The show will run in accordance with USEF Rules. Show management has the right to change or modify the prize list as needed the day of the show. Horse show management reserves the right to limit entries in any class or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any exhibitors, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes.
13. Add/Scratches must be done at the show office prior to the start of the division.
14. Haul-in only. No stabling available
15. Points count to the PA Equestrian Association
16. Series-ending prizes will be awarded at the 8/1 show– must participate in a minimum of three series shows to be eligible.

## Class Specifications

### Leadline Division

Open to junior riders 8 years old and under. No cross entry into other divisions.

### Mini Stirrup Division

Open to junior riders 10 years old and under. No cross entry into other divisions where jumping is permitted.

### Liberty Line Hack

Open to any horse or pony/rider combination that does not cross enter into any division exceeding 18"

### Short- Stirrup Divisions

Open to junior riders 12 years old and under. No cross entry into other divisions where jumping exceeds 18".

### Long Stirrup Divisions

Open to adult riders 18 years and over. No cross entry into other divisions where jumping exceeds 18".

### Baby Green Division

Open to horse or pony in their first or second year of showing. To be judged on horse or pony. Fence height is 2/3"

### The Tack Room Inc. Equitation Division

Sponsored by The Tack Room Inc. in Vicksburg, this division is open to any horse or pony ridden by amateur or child. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into any division exceeding 2' height. Course can include rollbacks, bending lines, trot jumps, and/or equitation style fences.

### Thoroughbred Hunter

To be judged on the horse, open to all thoroughbreds. 2'3" fence height.

### Low Children's Hunter Pony

Open to any child rider. Pony/rider combination may not cross enter into any division exceeding 2'.

### Modified Hunter

Open to any horse or pony ridden by an amateur or child. To be judged on the horse. Fence height of 2'. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into any division exceeding 2'.

### Suitable Hunter

Open to all. Fence height 2'3". Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into any division exceeding 2'.

### Children's Hunter Pony

Open to any child. To be judged on the pony. No cross entry into low pony division. Will run on an open card. 2' for smalls, 2'3" for mediums, and 2'6" for larges. Under saddle will follow the larges.

### Low Adult/Low Child Equitation

Open to any horse ridden by amateur adult or child. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into any division exceeding 2'6" height. Course can include rollbacks, bending lines, trot jumps, and/or equitation style fences.
