Pre-Surgery Instructions for Periodontal Surgery

- 1. Please verify that you have received your prescriptions and will take them as instructed.
- Do not eat or drink anything for at least 6 hours prior to surgery if you are scheduled for IV sedation. Please take any medications you normally take with just a small sip of water.
- 3. Plan on taking the rest of the school or workday off.
- 4. You will need ice bag compresses when you return home. We will give you extra gauze and a disposable compress to use on the way home. Tea bags can also be useful to help manage any post-operative bleeding events.
- 5. Prepare for a cold, soft diet for 2 days following the surgery. Smoothies, milkshakes, instant breakfast drinks, yogurt, etc., are recommended but take care to consume them using a spoon instead of a straw, as the suction through a straw could disrupt the healing process.
- 6. IF YOU WERE GIVEN A PARTIAL OR FLIPPER, PLEASE BRING IT WITH YOU TO THE SURGERY.
- 7. You are welcome to bring your own music to listen to during the procedure.
- 8. Minors scheduled for surgery must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Please do not bring children or pets with you. Arrange for someone to care for them during your surgery.
