General Membership Meeting with Rebecca Massie Lane, Director

at the Washington County Museum of Fine Arts

Tuesday, November 23rd at 3:00 PM

"A Peek into the Vault: A Virtual Tour of the Museum's Collection"

Rebecca Massie Lane, our speaker at last February's meeting, invited Valley Art members to gather at the Museum to learn about the collection. We have accepted her invitation, and that meeting will occur on November 23rd at 3:00 at the Museum. She will describe in more detail the Museum's extensive holdings, and share interesting background information about the artworks and how they were acquired. It promises to be a fascinating meeting!

Rebecca Massie Lane, the director of the Washington County Museum of Fine Arts since August 1, 2008, received her B.A. and M.A. in Art History from the University of Virginia, Charlottesville. Before coming to Hagerstown, she was Director of the Sweet Briar College Museums and Galleries, and was an Associate Professor. Program Director and Arts Management at Sweet Brian. While there, she managed the development of the permanent collection of art, and organized 12-14 exhibitions each year. Previously, she was Director of the Knoxville Museum of Art in Tennessee and held curatorial positions at the Virginia Museum of Fine Arts, Richmond, Virginia. Mrs. Lane also served as a grant panelist for the Institute of Museum and Library Services and the Virginia Commission for the Arts. To her credit are numerous other activities to advance the arts in and around Virginia.
