Don't put those paintbrushes down because there will be an all-member show at the Mansion House in August and September on the theme "Look Who's Turning 20." And don't forget the Anniversary Open House on September 9th from 5 to 7.

In other business, the Board has voted to close the Gallery on the following holidays when they fall on days that the Gallery would be open. This action recognizes that there tend to be few visitors on these dates and that it is difficult to get coverage. The Gallery will henceforth be closed on New Year's Eve, New Year's Day, the Friday after Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, and Christmas Day.

On a related note, the Board decided to continue scheduling occasional daytime meetings when there are suitable special events, but to maintain the evening schedule

for regular meetings.

Well, that's all the news from City Park, where the members of VAA are great, the interest in the arts is inspiring, and the artwork is most definitely above average.

May Membership Meeting with Demo Artist Lynn Ferris

Lynn Ferris is a signature member of the National Watercolor Society and the Florida Watercolor Society. Originally from New Jersey, she attended Moore College of Art in Philadelphia. She has worked as both a commercial and architectural illustrator. She is also a watercolor instructor, teaching both classes and workshops. Her limited edition prints are featured nationally by the French Creek Sheep and Wool Company and her watercolor entitled "the Group" appeared as cover art on the "Journal of the American Veterinary Medical Association." Lynn has participated in many one person and juried shows, where her work has received numerous awards. She was the subject of a feature article in "Watercolor" magazine, published by American Artist. Her work is included in the permanent collection of the Museum of Arts and Sciences in Daytona Beach, Florida.

In 2007, Lynn received the highest honor, the "Susan Lattner Lloyd Gold Award" in the 36th Annual Florida Watercolor Society Exhibit. Most recently she received the "Societies Award" in the 2008 competition. Her painting "Anna", was included in the 2010 NWS traveling exhibition.

Lynn teaches watercolor workshops at the Mansion House and will begin a workshop series here in June.
