Please take the time to review the policy and procedure for filling out the sales slips when someone purchases something. We have had several issues with the sales slips not being filled out with the name, etc. of the person purchasing the work, the person who sold the item, and there have been sales when the sales tax was not collected. Please read the guide for the credit card machine! This is not difficult to do we have it all written out for people to follow. The person righting up sales are responsible for collecting the sales tax and the individual artist are responsible for reporting to the Comptroller of the treasury. Sales tax is to be collected for all items sold at the Mansion House. There are resources on the desk to answer any questions one might have about the policy. You may also ask ANY member on the board about the training for sitting at the Mansion House. In order for members to be paid for their artwork, sales the guidelines MUST be followed.
