November Guest Speaker Thomas H. Renner, Artist

Tom was born in Hagerstown, Maryland in 1948. Attended Hagerstown Community College and Columbus College of Art and Design in Columbus, Ohio.

Tom enlisted in the U.S. Air Force and served from 1969 to 1972. After serving in the military he returned to college and earned a Bachelor's Degree in Art Education from Shepherd College. He continued his education and earned a Master's Degree in Secondary Education from Maryland University. He was an adjunct faculty member in art at Hagerstown Community College for 20 years and worked summers as a graphic designer and illustrator for GS Images in Hagerstown for 16 years.

Tom's approach to creating images has been very eclectic. Experimenting with realistic, symbolic and abstract styles. He allows the message or feel of the idea determine the method involved in its creation. He purposes to create a sense of spiritual and social connections, and a serendipity between himself and the work. He works mainly in acrylics and creates drawings that may lead to finished works. Tom has always participated in local exhibits such as the Cumberland Valley Artist's Exhibition and shows at the Washington County Arts Council Gallery. He was invited to exhibit his work in the 2011 "Wyeth Family of Artists" exhibition at the Washington County Museum of Fine Art. Tom has also exhibited his work at the Hagerstown Community College.
