Attention Mansion House Gallery Members: The Gallery wall changes will take place on Tuesday June 22, 2021. Those with wall spaces may come to the Mansion House at 10am on that date to begin to move their artwork clockwise to the next wall space of the same size. At 11am any wall changes in progress will pause for a Gallery meeting. All Gallery members are required to attend this meeting, whether they have a wall space or another space where they sell their artwork. That includes people who are displaying and selling in shrink wrap bins, cabinets, cases, miniature rack, tops of bookcases, or on pedestals (cards & bookmarks are excluded). The meeting will provide updated Gallery Policy information, which includes space prices and updated information about sitting requirements and Gallery practices. You will also be able to sign up for your required sitting dates, pay for your space, and sign your yearly Gallery Contract. After the meeting, people may stay and continue installing their artwork. Please make sure all of your artwork is securely labeled with your name, title (if any) and price, as well as being correctly prepared for display. NOTE: Presently there are two small wall spaces available. If you cannot attend the Gallery meeting, or if you have any questions, please notify a Gallery Director or a Board member.
