Washington County Museum of Fine Arts, Hagerstown City Park

Through January 14, 2023, *Color in Freedom: Journey Along the Underground Railroad*. The Maryland native and resident artist Joseph Holston leads his audience through four "movements", as in a symphony, that deepen our

understanding of America's Black enslaved people's experience. The exhibition features more than 50 paintings, etchings, and drawings that were created to enhance viewers' understanding of the condition of slavery, and the powerful instinct toward freedom. Through January 29, 2023, *From the Pages of PAN: Art Nouveau Prints, 1895-1900*: More than 80 prints from the Berlin-based art, literature, and applied art periodical *PAN*, whose 21 issues were published in three editions of increasing luxury between 1895 and 1900. These prints, from the collection of the Richard H. Driehaus Museum, Chicago, include works by Rodin, Toulouse-Lautrec, Kollwitz, Beardsley, Seurat and others. Exhibit runs through January 29, 2023.
