The information maintained in the log was an important part of our recent grant applications, which have resulted in the awarding of \$5,500 to VAA from the Maryland State Arts Council in 2023. (A third grant request is still pending.)

There will be a mandatory gallery meeting and wall changes on Tuesday, June 20<sup>th</sup> beginning at 9 am. Gallery members will be paying their fees for their spaces, signing new contracts for FY 2023-2024 and signing up for sitting dates also on or before June 20th.

# PROCEDURES FOR CREATING VAA WEBSITE MEMBER SECTIONS 5/1/23

All Valley Art members are invited to request a section on the VAA website member page, which will be maintained as long as the member is in good standing. For members who do not have a website, this is a nice alternative, and one of the perks of VAA membership. To request a member section, please send the following information to the website liaison (currently Sue Parker at <a href="mailto:scp2art@gmail.com">scp2art@gmail.com</a>) who will arrange for the information to be uploaded to the Valley Art website.

The format for Valley Art Association website member information has changed. A searchable section will be created as part of a master compilation of VAA member artists who request to be included on VAA's website. If a member has <u>both</u> a section on VAA's website and a personal website, the link on VAA's "Members and Community" page will now go to the member's section on VAA's site. A link to the member's personal website can still be included within the narrative in the member's VAA section. (Members who currently have their websites as their VAA member page can leave those links until their new member page is set up.) This change should ensure that if members change or discontinue their personal websites, their VAA member section will not be altered or disappear.

The current plan, unless a member requests otherwise, is for member sections to stay on the VAA site indefinitely in a "Past Member" archive when the member leaves VAA.

Each member section will contain up to 500 words of text, furnished by the member, and may include up to 8 images (see specifications below), as well as member contact information and website links.

The images furnished should be as large as possible, with a minimum of 600px high preferred. The image on the "Members and Community" page, which will be the link to the member's section, should be wider than it is tall (called a "landscape orientation") for best display. The other images will become part of a slide show in the member's personal section. If captions are to be included (e.g. the titles of paintings/images), they should have the following format:

cap-(caption goes here).jpg or png

For example:

cap-The-Girl-with-the-Pearl-Earring.jpg

cap-Mona-Lisa.jpg

After review, member submissions will be submitted to Valley Art's website manager for uploading onto VAA's web page.
