- Structure: Title, Authors and affiliation, email, Background, Objectives, Methods, Results, Conclusion.
- -Label the File as 'Oral Presentation (Author Name-NEMPSCON Reg. No.)'
- -Accepted Abstracts will receive email notification

- 1. Abstract Submission
- Same format as oral presentation.
- -Label the File as 'Poster Presentation(Author Name-NEMPSCON Reg. No)'
- 2. Poster Specifications
- Size: 36 inches x 48 inches, portrait.
- Sections: Title, Code, Introduction, Objectives, Methodology, Results, Conclusion, References.
- Put the assigned code in the right hand corner. Underline the name of the presenting author.
- Mount poster at designated area 1 hour before session.
- Presenting author must be available during evaluation.
- Ensure text is legible and visuals are high resolution.



Places to visit in Guwahati

I. Kamakhya Temple

One of the most sacred Shakti Peethas in India, located atop Nilachal Hill. It attracts pilgrims from across the country.

2. Umananda Temple & Island

Situated on the world's smallest inhabited river island in the Brahmaputra. You can reach it via a short ferry ride.

3. Assam State Museum

A must-visit for history and culture lovers, showcasing ancient artifacts, tribal art, and textiles.

4. Guwahati Planetarium

A popular attraction for science enthusiasts and students, with regular shows on astronomy.

5. Brahmaputra River Cruise

Offers a scenic view of the river, sunset, and city skyline. Alfresco Grand is one of the most popular cruise services.

6. Srimanta Sankardev Kalakshetra

A cultural complex celebrating Assamese heritage, with museums, open-air theaters, and traditional architecture.

7. Navagraha Temple

Dedicated to the nine celestial bodies, this temple also offers a panoramic view of Guwahati.

8. Basistha Ashram

A peaceful pilgrimage site believed to be founded by the sage Vashistha, with waterfalls and natural surroundings.

9. Purva Tirupati Balaji Temple

A replica of the Tirupati Balaji temple, known for its South Indian architecture and spiritual ambiance.

10. Dipor Bil (Deepor Beel)

A freshwater lake and bird sanctuary on the outskirts of Guwahati. A haven for birdwatchers and nature lovers.
