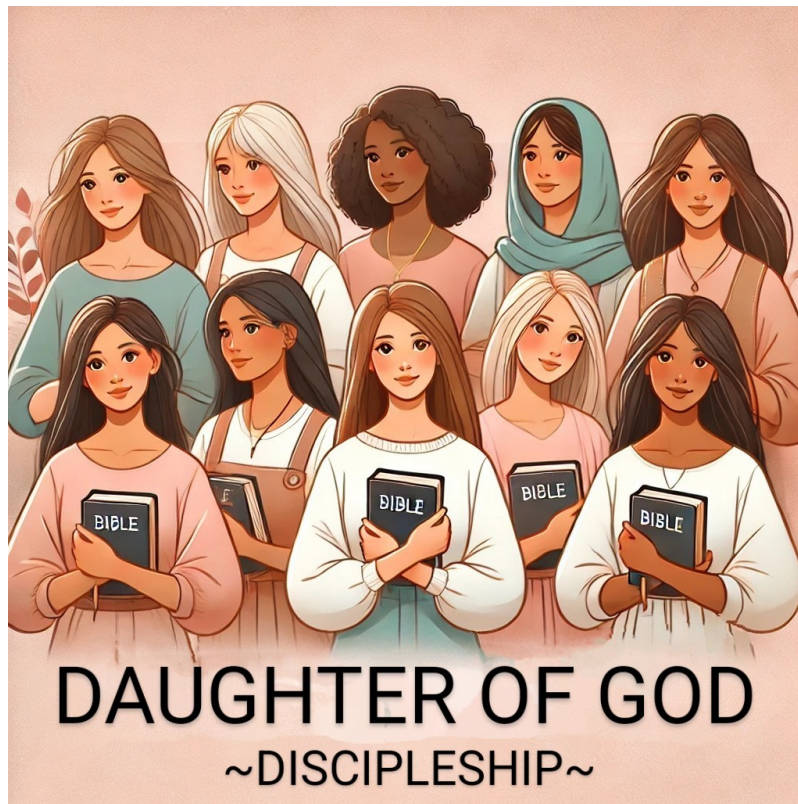




7-Day Bible Study on the Book of James
