Cataract Surgery Eye Drop Schedule

- >Only one drop of each medication should be used.
- >Spread out the drop use evenly throughout the day.
- >Close the eye for one minute after using each drop.
 - >Do not touch the tip of the bottle to the eye.
 - >Wait 10 minutes between using each drop.

Week 1:

*Use <u>Pred Forte</u> (Prednisolone) {Pink or White top} <u>4 times</u> daily in operative eye. (Shake before using)

- *Use <u>Acular</u> (Ketorolac) {Gray top} <u>4 times daily</u> in operative eye.
- *Use <u>Vigamox</u> (Moxifloxacin) {Tan/ Beige Top} <u>4 times</u> daily in operative eye.

Week 2:

- *Use Pred Forte (Prednisolone) 3 times daily in operative eye.
- *Use Acular (Ketorolac) 4 times daily in operative eye.
- * Stop <u>Vigamox</u> (Moxifloxacin)

Week 3:

- *Use Pred Forte 2 times daily.
- *Use Acular (Ketorolac) 4 times daily.

Week 4:

- *Use Pred Forte 1 time daily.
- *Continue Acular (Ketorolac) 4 times daily.

After week 4 discontinue drops unless instructed otherwise.

- During the day, use glasses or shield to keep eyes protected, at night wear the shield for 1 week after the surgery to protect your operative eye.
- Do not lift anything over 10 lbs, or bend below the waist.
- Avoid any soap or water getting directly into operative eye for 7 days.
- No driving until physician approved
- Avoid any dirty/ sweaty activity for 7 days. (yard work, swimming, exercising)
- *** Please call if you experience any pain, decreased vision, redness, or if you are seeing flashes of light or an increased amount of floaters.
