Call for Expressions of Interest (EOIs)

Dumaresq Solar Farm (the “Project”) is located within the Inverell Shire Council, with the Project site being located between the towns of Ashford and Bonshaw, north of Inverell and west of Tenterfield.

The Project will occupy between 200 and 205 hectares once constructed and has a project life of up to 40 years. The Project site is intersected by Transgrid’s Dumaresq to Bulli Creek 330kV Transmission Lines. In addition to PV Panels, the Project will likely include significant Battery Energy Storage.

Progress of EIS Packages of Works

This EOI process is at an early stage and there is no representation that the Scope of Works will proceed on any timetable, nor at all. Any Scope of Works may be subject to change.
