Call for Expressions of Interest (EOIs)

Dumaresq Solar Farm (the “Project”) is located within the Inverell Shire Council, with the Project site being located between the towns of Ashford and Bonshaw.

The Project will occupy between 200 and 205 hectares once constructed and has a project life of up to 40 years. The Project site is intersected by Transgrid’s Dumaresq to Bulli Creek 330kV Transmission Lines. In addition to PV Panels, the Project will include Battery Energy Storage.

### Scope of Works

The high level scope for this work package is based on providing a an independent investigation & assessment of the potential Visual & Glare Impacts that might result from the Project once constructed. It is anticipated that any Assessment Report will be a combination of desktop analysis and in field analysis, including through use of various best practice Solar Assessment Tools.

Interested parties might review the Scoping Report that posted both on the Project Website ([www.dumaresqsolarfarm.com](http://www.dumaresqsolarfarm.com)) and the NSW Major Projects Portal. In that Scoping Report the position of site to Bonshaw Road and various neighbouring properties is detailed.

The exact scope of the package works will be outlined in the detailed Request For Proposal (RFP) that will be issued to parties that are invited to tender.

That RFP will also outline information required to be submitted on other data points including capabilities & experience (*including with solar developments in general and the Northern Tablelands Region in particular*), potential conflicts of interest, personnel & insurances.



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This EOI process is at an early stage and there is no representation that the Scope of Works will proceed on any timetable, nor at all. Any Scope of Works may be subject to change, and it is noted that the Project awaits the issue of SEARs.
