



Our Mission

The mission of the <u>Canada 911 Ride Foundation</u> is to honor and preserve the legacy of fallen emergency first responders—police, fire, and EMS—who have bravely sacrificed their lives in the line of duty.

We achieve this by placing Automated External Defibrillator (AED) devices in their names, ensuring their life-saving spirit continues to serve the community. In addition, we provide post-secondary educational support to the children of these heroes and collaborate with the Mikey Network to expand the availability of public access AEDs, further embedding their legacy into the fabric of our communities.



Over the past 19 years, our foundation proudly raised hundreds of thousands of dollars to fulfill its mission, making a meaningful impact on countless lives through various initiatives. Highlights of our efforts included:

- Honoring the Legacy of Fallen Emergency First Responders
 We commemorated emergency first responders who made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty by dedicating public-access Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) in their honor. This initiative ensured their legacy endured, empowering communities and allowing their service to continue saving lives even in their absence.
- Empowering the Children of Fallen Heroes
 We supported the children of fallen emergency service first responders by providing educational bursaries. These bursaries alleviated financial barriers and enabled them to pursue post-secondary education, helping them achieve their dreams and build brighter futures.

Examples How Your Sponsorship Helps...

- Our partnership with The Mikey Network has saved over 50 lives to date, with the number continuing to grow.
- We solemnly remembered the RCMP officers who lost their lives in the tragic 2014 Moncton shootings, where three members were killed and two others severely injured.
 - Constable Fabrice Georges Gevaudan, Constable Douglas James Larche, and Constable Dave Joseph Ross
- In 2020, we honored Ontario Provincial Police Constable Marc Hovingh, who made the
 ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty.
- In 2022, we launched a special campaign for Toronto Police Constable Andrew Hong, who
 was killed in the line of duty. Funds raised are supporting his two children in their post-secondary
 education.
- In 2023, we paid tribute to five Ontario police officers who lost their lives in 2022:
 - Toronto Police Service Constable Andrew Hong, OPP Constable Greg Pierzchala, South Simcoe Police Service Constables Morgan Russell & Devon Northrup, and York Regional Police Constable Travis Gillespie
- In 2024, we recognized the sacrifice of **OPP Sergeant Eric Mueller**, who was tragically killed in the line of duty on May 11, 2023, while responding to a disturbance call in Bourget, Ontario.
