

Our Mission

The foundations mission includes honouring the memories of emergency service first responders who have died in the line of duty; assisting the children left behind by way of financial assistance for their post secondary endeavours; helping children who have been the victim of violent crime; and working in conjunction with the Mikey Network to make public defibrillators more readily available to help save lives.



Over the last 18 years, the foundation has successfully raised over \$1,000,000.00 in support of its causes and has made presentations to various recipients and organizations, as detailed below:

Honoring Fallen Emergency First Responders

We commemorate the memories of emergency first responders who have made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty by dedicating a public access Automated External Defibrillator (AED) in their name. This initiative ensures that their legacy endures, allowing them to continue serving their community even in their absence.

Assisting the Children of Fallen Emergency Service First Responders

Our commitment extends to supporting the children of fallen emergency service first responders. We provide educational bursaries to assist them in pursuing their post-secondary endeavors, aiming to ease the financial burden and contribute to their educational pursuits.

Some Examples How Your Donation is Used

- Our ongoing collaboration with <u>The Mikey Network</u> has resulted in saving 48 lives to date and counting.
- We solemnly remembered the three RCMP officers who lost their lives during the <u>2014 Moncton</u> <u>shootings</u>, where a total of three RCMP members were killed, and two others were severely injured.
- In memory of 10-year-old Julianna Kozis, a victim of the July 2019 <u>Danforth shooting</u>, we placed two Automated External Defibrillator (AED) units to commemorate her short life.
- We paid tribute to the memory of Ontario Provincial Police Cst. Marc Hovingh, who tragically lost his life in the line of duty in 2020.
- In 2022, we established a Go Fund Me page for <u>Toronto Police Cst. Andrew Hong</u>, who was killed in the line of duty. The funds raised are dedicated to assisting his two children with their post-secondary education.
- In 2023, our plan is to honor the five Ontario police officers who tragically lost their lives in 2022:
 Toronto Police Service Cst. Andrew Hong, OPP Cst. Greg Pierzchala, South Simcoe Police Service
 Constables Morgan Russell and Devon Northrup, and York Regional Police Cst. Travis Gillespie.
