

LETECIA STAUCH: What?

ALBERT STAUCH: Do what?

LETECIA STAUCH: What?

ALBERT STAUCH: I'm, uh, just trying to help get to the bottom of this, Tecia. Like you said in the message like I'm just trying to do this for Gannon.

LETECIA STAUCH: Yeah but this whole time, for three weeks you've been just like all these people so you know what, I'ma be just like 'em too full speculation, full of lies, full of craziness, I'ma be fuckin' crazy as hell just like them.

ALBERT STAUCH: So you're starting that *now*?

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] that's the truth how -

ALBERT STAUCH: You're starting that *now* is what you're telling me?

LETECIA STAUCH: No. I'm telling you. No. That's how you treated me.

ALBERT STAUCH: No.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] sitting there playing this, your game, and all the listening you think I'm that [inaudible]

ALBERT STAUCH: No I'm just trying to, like I said, I'm just trying to get to the truth and get to Gannon.

LETECIA STAUCH: Do you think I'm stupid?

ALBERT STAUCH: No, you think I'm stupid.

LETECIA STAUCH: Do you think that you wanted to get to Gannon?

ALBERT STAUCH: Yeah.

LETECIA STAUCH: And you think I'm not gonna fuckin' be a fuckin' crazy ass? Do you think that for a second? You think I'm not smart enough ? I'm not because oh my god I worshipped the ground you walked on.

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay, but, that being said, why would you give me Nicole's number?

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible]

ALBERT STAUCH: No, that's fine, that's fine, we're miles away from that, so.

LETECIA STAUCH: Miles away from what?

ALBERT STAUCH: Miles away from the truth first of all, 'cause this Quincy guy's been gone for two years. The news said that not me, okay, alright, the news said they also got confirmation from the sheriff ok that this guy was not involved period, it's misinformation.

LETECIA STAUCH: If that's what they say then they have the answer.

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay, well but between me and you why can't we just move past Quincy okay.

LETECIA STAUCH: Because you're not trying to move forward in your fight for your wife and your family and as long as you trust me like that act like that I'm gonna be the same damn way.

ALBERT STAUCH: Ok but you, but hear me out, hear me out.

LETECIA STAUCH: Treating me like shit and you think I'm supposed to come be your hero?

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay, listen, I am trying to get past that point because -

LETECIA STAUCH: No, you're not.

ALBERT STAUCH: Quincy being involved in this -

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] made it so we don't have anywhere to live and no food [inaudible] lay up in a hotel.

ALBERT STAUCH: Yeah, but you had me believing Quincy until the news and the El Paso told me it wasn't true.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] you don't care.

ALBERT STAUCH: I do.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] we don't even matter to you.

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay, so you've been telling me stories this whole time, is that what you're telling me? You've been lying to me intentionally?

LETECIA STAUCH: No. [inaudible] why not?

ALBERT STAUCH: So.

LETECIA STAUCH: Why not? Because -

ALBERT STAUCH: But you've gotta, no I think you're freaking out because you know, I don't even have to tell you, you know that Quincy being not legit anymore is not good for you and it's not good for Gannon.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] but okay.

ALBERT STAUCH: Alright so listen, I wanna start over with this okay. I wanna start over and I -

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] now.

ALBERT STAUCH: No, I got you and I want you.

LETECIA STAUCH: You don't have me. If you have me you wouldn't have abandoned me for two weeks.

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay, but listen. When I started talking to you on the phone the most honest you've been to me in this whole frickin' process is when you asked me and you showed me that

you cared and loved me you asked, 'Albert do you love me.' And I answered and I said yes, right?

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] Albert you don't love me.

ALBERT STAUCH: No, no, no listen to me, I said yes, ok.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] and tell them all [inaudible]

ALBERT STAUCH: I said yes and what you said, ok, what you said if this was an accident will you stand by me and I said yes. I said I will stand by you if this was an accident.

LETECIA STAUCH: How many people did you start texting and telling them I was lying? I just wanna know because this is where it gets where I know you [inaudible] on people, this is why I know you never were trusted through the whole two weeks.

ALBERT STAUCH: Wasn't trusted? I didn't get on the phone and text nobody about this and I know you're surprised by that and you can be, ok.

LETECIA STAUCH: Whatever you ain't told a soul about no names or nothing?

ALBERT STAUCH: The only person I've been talking about is the fact that Quincy Brown with this whatever Nicole Fiaro told me that the El Paso County Sheriff's Office you said call. I did exactly what you said, I trusted in you, I got in touch with them.

LETECIA STAUCH: Three weeks.

ALBERT STAUCH: So you don't even wanna talk about Gannon. You're not talking about Gannon, you're talking about you, ok.

LETECIA STAUCH: No, this is not about [inaudible]

ALBERT STAUCH: It is about you.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] wanna know why?

ALBERT STAUCH: That's not true, Gannon - 'Cause you're somewhere, you're healthy and talking to me. Gannon's not, that's why it's about Gannon ok, alright. Like I said I want your honesty, the most honest you've been.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] don't even understand any of it. If I tried to tell you [inaudible] that's your fucking baby momma have something to do with it? You're not gonna believe me but she did.

ALBERT STAUCH: Ok, then let's prove it, give me the proof.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] for you to fucking laugh at hotels with her.

ALBERT STAUCH: I haven't once, I've told you that. I don't care, you can accuse me all you want to like you've done for five years. I don't have nothing to hide.

LETECIA STAUCH: You won't even tell me anything. You haven't had the decency to tell me anything about nothing. You started kicking me off and kicking me to the curb but you saw her everyday though didn't you.

ALBERT STAUCH: Not really, actually.

LETECIA STAUCH: Oh, 'cause she's your children's mother right.

ALBERT STAUCH: Yep, absolutely and you have information that you're not telling me and you have the chance to show that you're better than her, ok. If she's involved in this, if she's involved in it let's take her down, if she's -

LETECIA STAUCH: You go make a statement that you are standing by your wife and then see what you get.

ALBERT STAUCH: Ok, if you sit right here I will do that ok. If you sit right -

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] liar.

ALBERT STAUCH: No, no absolutely not. I'm not putting you down at all. You told me the closest we've been to the truth, I'm gonna keep saying this, is when you asked me if I loved you and I said yes ok and then you said if this was an accident and then you said stand by me. Okay, so that I think that's the closest to the truth we've been that something happened, it was an accident and that's the most -

LETECIA STAUCH: If something happened that was an accident where the hell did I put Gannon? What you think. what the rest of the people think, you think it was an accident and that I hurt him and did away with him.

ALBERT STAUCH: Listen hold on, hold on I'm gonna tell you the truth right now. I'm not worried about Gannon right now I'm worried about you. I'm worried about standing by you.

LETECIA STAUCH: Yeah, you tell me what I want to hear.

ALBERT STAUCH: I'm not telling you what you want to hear. That's the only way to move forward with this is that it was an accident which I think is the truth and that you freaked out and I've told you that over and over and over again. Accidents happen, people freak out with accidents, they will understand that ok but the fact that you sent me on a three day chase of Quincy Brown, which is misinformation and not true, ok, that's not good for you. What's good for you is that we can make it through this going down the road of an accident, no I'm telling you the truth.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] of people don't make it through. If I haven't saved Gannon's life in a fire you'd still be treating me the same way.

ALBERT STAUCH: You saved his life from a fire?

LETECIA STAUCH: If I didn't, if I didn't, God knows because I couldn't figure out where the hell the fire was coming from and Gannon was downstairs [inaudible] jumped on me for a second if that couch was on fire Gannon would not be alive.

ALBERT STAUCH: No, I said that from day one that you did what you had to do there but how did you save his life, ok. Was the, what was it from the accident of the candle that Gannon did or what that's what.

LETECIA STAUCH: Had I just laid back down because I'd already put the darn alarm off, already put the alarm off -

ALBERT STAUCH: Yeah, but you're a good person, you're a good mom. That's what good people do, ok, so that's never been in question. The fact that you're a good person, that's, that just comes natural okay. The fact that what happened subsequent to that, what happened after that was just for made the accident it compounded it ten times, ten times, ten times, and now it's got way out of hand but that's the only way we get out of this is to figure out what the accident was and go from there.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible]

ALBERT STAUCH: I can't hear you.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] we don't have any food!

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay, alright.

LETECIA STAUCH: Yeah, gee, alright thanks that's really great right. Albert?

ALBERT STAUCH: Yeah, I'm, here.

LETECIA STAUCH: I told you every single day, I woke up every single day and told you I want to tell you that I'm this bad person and something bad, I wanna tell you all that. I do.

ALBERT STAUCH: Why?

LETECIA STAUCH: Because! That's what you think. You have trashed me to everyone.

ALBERT STAUCH: I have not, prove it. I have not trashed you to no one. I have not put anything out in the public intentionally so we can get to the bottom of this me and you ok. And here we are trying to get to the bottom of it.

LETECIA STAUCH: Sure, sure you have your family thinking I'm a murderer.

ALBERT STAUCH: My family's not even here, I'm all alone again I told you that. My family just wants to find their nephew, their grandson, their cousin ok. That's what they want. How about Laina, their brother. Laina's losing her mind 'cause her brother's missing.

LETECIA STAUCH: You think I don't wanna see Laina?

ALBERT STAUCH: I didn't say see Laina, I said Laina's freaking out 'cause Gannon's missing, what are you talking about?

LETECIA STAUCH: I know I said I do wanna see Laina.

ALBERT STAUCH: I didn't say you didn't wanna see here, why, where did that come from? I said grandma's, my mom's worried about her grandson ok. My siblings are worried about their nephew. Their children are worried about their cousin. And then I said Laina's worried about her brother and you said you wanna see Laina.

LETECIA STAUCH: I do.

ALBERT STAUCH: Well everybody wants to see Gannon. Everybody!

LETECIA STAUCH: I know that Albert.



ALBERT STAUCH: Everybody wants to see Gannon and I'm trying to get you to understand that if this was just an accident and it got out of hand and you panicked or whoever panicked okay that's something we can make it through okay. You can make it through that.

LETECIA STAUCH: You're not gonna believe that 'cause you're gonna [inaudible]

ALBERT STAUCH: No, fine Gannon panicked.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible]

ALBERT STAUCH: No, no, I'm not blaming you. I said it was an accident. Accidents really have no one to blame. If an accident happens.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] okay I was trying to be a cool parent I already told you that, we pushed the beds together, he was talking about having a sleepover.

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay.

LETECIA STAUCH: We were just acting crazy ok I already told you that Gannon fell and busted his lip and his toe that's where the blood came from y'all keep thinking there's some crime scene you kicked everybody out of the house when that's not even, nothing happened to Gannon, deadly hurtful anything like that in the home. I'm sick of it [inaudible] How am I supposed to help people when people won't even move past that. I told you this morning, that was the accident I was talking about.

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay, so there was an accident with Gannon, ok, that's what I'm trying to say so next what, I mean that's what I -

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] ok.

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] feeling horrible, he's absolutely feeling horrible because we had a fire we had to run out, he's thinking that [inaudible] or whatever you're gonna say you're gonna be like, oh my you know whatever, you're not gonna let me just tell you and be genuine unless you just be like maybe how can you like even deal with this cause i'm dealing with it hard and comfort each other you're not gonna do that. You think it's not killing me? Do you think that for a second?

ALBERT STAUCH: No, I know it's killing you. I know how you are when - cause you're a good mom and you're a good person and when things don't go perfect I know how you are.

LETECIA STAUCH: Albert do you love me?

ALBERT STAUCH: Yes.

LETECIA STAUCH: Okay. What is the truth are you going - don't tell me to make you no promises, are you gonna make this right and stand by your wife?

ALBERT STAUCH: I told you that the other day I will stand by you, yes.

LETECIA STAUCH: And I said are you gonna make this right?

ALBERT STAUCH: Yeah, we're gonna make this whole situation right.

LETECIA STAUCH: I'm talking about our family.

ALBERT STAUCH: Absolutely, that's why I, that's what this is all about is our family. I said that from day 1 and every day, this is about our family.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] okay. [inaudible] because all I kept thinking about is how he was supposed - I don't know what if somebody was supposed to be sending him online on Amazon. I don't know what promises people have made, I don't know how any kind of promises that people made about coming to an Arch .I don't know about any of that. I just know he was

thinking that A) His dad wont give him no [inaudible] he was upset about the whole candle thing and he kept saying to me that he messes up everything, saying that to me and I kept saying no you didn't that's why I didn't let Gannon go to school. He felt horrible with himself, he felt really bad with himself, he was very upset so we go on our same trips and [inaudible] about the bike [inaudible] we've we did all that, all that's true. We did all that. We go to PetCo. We did all that.

ALBERT STAUCH: Ok.

LETECIA STAUCH: Then we leave, we go we're supposed to meet somebody about the bikes then end up and I realize that I did think somebody was following us, that's the god's honest truth because when I got over, they got over, I go to turn they go to turn. I swear to God I somebody was following us all the time. Anyway, so I realize that I didn't have a phone for directions so I turned around. Turned back up to PetCo, go back in to PetCo, he's still playing the switch. If you think for a second on some video he might've been whatever, he had busted his nose and his mouth, did you think I wanna send him to school like that? Honestly. Did you?

ALBERT STAUCH: I mean obviously not.

LETECIA STAUCH: Ok. I didn't and then he was feeling so sorry, he didn't have bad burns. It was barely - They was a little bit bubbly but I was able to jump on it and put it out. So then we go back to PetCo and I said, 'Gannon hey we're gonna have to hurry up and get back and get Laina.' Albert, when I got back, Gannon was not in the car. At all. I didn't even know that he wasn't in the car.

ALBERT STAUCH: From when you left PetCo?

LETECIA STAUCH: I feel horrible because I feel like one of those people that didn't realize that they've left their baby in the car! Now I have to sit back and have people fuss at me and say first of all where's Gannon, I don't know. I told you this from the beginning. I don't know. I don't! You think it's not driving me insane I don't know? You think I don't have to feel like a whatever [inaudible] you think I didn't even pay attention! He's always just so quiet I wasn't even thinking and then I go into PetCo(?) thinking surely he's gonna be home, surely 'cause he was talking about a friend with a car, his brother had a car, i said surely maybe he thinks he feels horrible to call this person or do whatever and he'll be back home. That's it. And you think I don't have to live with this every single day?

ALBERT STAUCH: [whispering on his end]

LETECIA STAUCH: Hello?

ALBERT STAUCH: I'm here, I'm just listening.

LETECIA STAUCH: See now you're just listening. I give you what you want and you're just listening.

ALBERT STAUCH: What do you want me to do? Dou want me to pick holes in it? I promised you I'd listen, you asked me to listen, I'm promisin'.

LETECIA STAUCH: Oh, so now there's holes to pick in it?

ALBERT STAUCH: That's not, I mean I can if you want me to, do you wanna do that?

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible]

ALBERT STAUCH: Alright listen, listen, listen, listen, listen, listen. I'm done okay. Because we started off talking about an accident okay, now basically we got another QB so what's this guy's name okay. When you come up with that, when you come up with the next person's name, you call me back, alright.
