

ALBERT STAUCH: Hello?

LETECIA STAUCH: I didn't get anything but question marks.

ALBERT STAUCH: Oh, I said did you wanna talk about like, did you set up an appointment for this? How much is it gonna cost?

LETECIA STAUCH: No, [inaudible] my approach is if you don't - in my opinion, and this is how I want it to be so there's no like you know question or anything. If you don't control the aspect of it as far as immunity, checking [inaudible], like [inaudible] you will try to take it, [inaudible] and say that based on what you do or - I just don't - I want to prove 100% to you because I know you're hurt, I know you're upset, but those things are not true what you said. They're just not true. And I don't care about the court of law because you know why my attorney will shred it apart. I'm worried about my husband knowing that I did not do something ?

ALBERT STAUCH: Alright, well.

LETECIA STAUCH: Because I care about you and I feel like if you know the truth that I did not then everything could be okay.

ALBERT STAUCH: Yeah, I -

LETECIA STAUCH: I mean, right? If you know for 100% that I did not, hurt the child, kill our child, hit 'em with 2x4s, whatever you may say, would it not make you feel a lot different right now?

ALBERT STAUCH: Yeah, I told you I'd stand by you with the truth, you know, and I pulled up that link and uh and I mean it got 5 stars so it looks legit on the surface. Uh, yeah, and I mean you hit a good... You hit a great point there, you know, about, you know, how I am about

validating things and looking into things. Part of that process would be you know getting some questions answered that I want answered right, I think you can assume that, right?

LETECIA STAUCH: Ok.

ALBERT STAUCH: So that being said, um, I got - As I was waiting on you to get back I wrote down basically three or four questions and I wanna pose them to you now so that way I'm not surprised when I go in there, okay? Are you willing to do that with me? And then we'll -

LETECIA STAUCH: - you're not surprised? Or -

ALBERT STAUCH: Neither one of us, so you know the questions and I know the questions.

LETECIA STAUCH: Oh yeah okay. I get what you're saying, yep.

ALBERT STAUCH: Yeah, so I'll ask them and you just give me yes - It's simple yes or no questions, ok. So you're not - Once again, I'm tryina be fair to you and fair to myself. These are some of the questions that I want answered. Uhm, number one, do you know where Gannon is? Yes or no?

LETECIA STAUCH: No. I mean, but these are the questions I'm gonna prove to you too, right? That's what you're saying?

ALBERT STAUCH: Right.

LETECIA STAUCH: Ok.

ALBERT STAUCH: You can answer them now but then you can answer them then as well, ok. Who was Gannon last with?

LETECIA STAUCH: On a lie detector they don't ask you questions like that.

ALBERT STAUCH: Right, I'm sorry, it's yes or no. Uhm, do you know who Gannon was with last?

LETECIA STAUCH: Ok, so here's what I want you to be careful with on 'do you know who Gannon was with last?' Let me explain to you!

ALBERT STAUCH: Yeah, go ahead. I'm sorry, go ahead.

LETECIA STAUCH: You have to have a specific approach on that because you need to say, 'do you know a description or have a picture in your mind of who Gannon was with last?'

ALBERT STAUCH: Ok, how about it this way, were you the last person Gannon was with?

LETECIA STAUCH: No.

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay, that leads into -

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] to ask the question of someone else with me.

ALBERT STAUCH: Right, right. Yeah, I know and I'm not gonna probably be the one phrasing the questions I'm just telling you questions I want answered. So, you answered the question were you the last person Gannon was with, and you said -

LETECIA STAUCH: No.

ALBERT STAUCH: No. Okay. And I'll leave it at that. I'm not gonna go take that down a rabbit trail, ok. Did you accidentally hurt Gannon?

LETECIA STAUCH: No.

ALBERT STAUCH: Did you murder Gannon?

LETECIA STAUCH: No.

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay. Well, so. I mean. That's kinda, that's some of the questions I'm gonna want answered, so, when are you gonna be able to do this? I wanna get this done as soon as possible. I'm ready to do it tomorrow. I think it, because of publicity in this case they'll squeeze you in and make an appointment for you tomorrow if we go up there and call 'em and say, 'listen this is the Gannon Stauch case, we need a polygraph ASAP.' Let's do it uhm, I don't know. When's the earliest you can do it? I'll just take money out of the bank account and I'll pay for it.

LETECIA STAUCH: So can you get me just a like two or three times, or days and times, that they have available, send them to me and I'll give you exactly which one would work best.

ALBERT STAUCH: No, Tecia. Tecia this is -

LETECIA STAUCH: Talking like I have - I don't have a way around, okay.

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay.

LETECIA STAUCH: - help people out so that I could have food and a place to stay.

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay. And, but -

LETECIA STAUCH: I'm the one said to do this.

ALBERT STAUCH: But I'll even get you tomorrow morning. I wanna do it like 8 or 9 o'clock in the morning. I'll come and get you at Michelle's house okay, and I'll bring you to this place. It's Michelle, right?

LETECIA STAUCH: I'm not at Michelle's house.

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay, where you at now?

LETECIA STAUCH: I'm staying with random people, people that reached out online, people that are following the case.

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay, well send me your location through your phone or send me an address or a ten digit grid coordinate from Google Earth.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] time and you're telling me you're gonna pick me up?

ALBERT STAUCH: Yeah 'cause I guarantee you they will squeeze you in tomorrow because this'll be another star in their cap, another feather in their cap.

LETECIA STAUCH: Why 'cause it's about some publicity [inaudible]?

ALBERT STAUCH: No, no, no, not me. I want the truth and you know what? Every minute, every second we sit here and talk about this is another minute that Gannon is in danger.

LETECIA STAUCH: I told you I would do this and [inaudible] in person.

ALBERT STAUCH: Alright well tomorrow's the day, okay. If not, then you're not serious about it. That's just, and I'm not -

LETECIA STAUCH: What are you talking about? I've already told you yes. I've already said yes, yes, yes.

ALBERT STAUCH: Alright I'll set the appointment. If it needs to be the afternoon, fine whatever but we'll do it, okay? Tomorrow.

LETECIA STAUCH: I've already, like, I don't know why you keep saying it like I've changed it. I've already said yes I also wanna know [inaudible] need to be 'cause I saw somewhere online it says something about eating and drinking and stuff like that, so.

ALBERT STAUCH: Alright, I'll answer that for you but, I mean, why don't you plan on like a six hour window or something, okay? And then -

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible]

ALBERT STAUCH: I'm just going based off generalizations, Tecia, come on now. I don't know the answer to that. You can Google it just like I can. I'll call them and I'll find out and I'm just saying plan on, if you think you're not supposed to eat for a while then don't eat for a while. It's not a big deal, but uhm I'll call them and I'll set it up for tomorrow, you know, afternoon.

Whatever. You just let me know where to come get you or let me know, you know, just be there if you don't want me to come get you.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] now you had your questions you wanted, and so now I have questions.

ALBERT STAUCH: So now I'm taking a polygraph?

LETECIA STAUCH: No, you're not taking a polygraph.

ALBERT STAUCH: No? Okay.

LETECIA STAUCH: I'm asking you four questions.

ALBERT STAUCH: Alright, go ahead with them.

LETECIA STAUCH: When you get the results that say I have passed this polygraph test what is your course of action?

ALBERT STAUCH: These are yes or no questions, please.

LETECIA STAUCH: Okay. Is your course of action to be with your wife and marriage and your daughter and the rest of our family, back to normal, and figure it out who has Gannon?

ALBERT STAUCH: No.

LETECIA STAUCH: That's not your - that's not your approach?

ALBERT STAUCH: You said once you answer some polygraph questions once we find Gannon, okay.

LETECIA STAUCH: That's not what I said.

ALBERT STAUCH: Alright alright okay, I didn't - Yes or no questions, I didn't do this to you. I took your yes or no questions.

LETECIA STAUCH: Okay. Once the polygraph test comes back and shows you that I'm telling the truth to the questions that I had nothing to do with Gannon in any kind of way being hurt, murdered, taken, whatever are you gonna be with your wife?

ALBERT STAUCH: Nope.

LETECIA STAUCH: Really? So, why?

ALBERT STAUCH: Yes or no questions, please.

LETECIA STAUCH: That's what I'm doing. I just want you to tell me why.

ALBERT STAUCH: 'Cause the key to standing by you is the truth and Gannon, so.

LETECIA STAUCH: I just told you if I pass a polygraph test and you know I didn't have anything to do with this. I'm trying to understand here why would you say no to being with your wife if I - If it's proven on the test that I didn't have anything to do with it. I just wanna know the truth on that. I'm still gonna do it so I can clear my name, I just wanna know the truth from you.

ALBERT STAUCH: I'm waiting for the next yes or no questions.

LETECIA STAUCH: Come on man, just be real with me, this is not the time to play games.

ALBERT STAUCH: I'm not Tecia, you gotta understand, there's too - Listen, listen. There's a lot of repair -

LETECIA STAUCH: Tell me the truth.

ALBERT STAUCH: I am, I'm trying to. I'm gonna bend here, again. G is the most important thing but there's a lot of emotions, there's a lot of damage, okay, from this situation and I don't - I'm not here to argue with you okay. But, there's a lot of damage - But, all the lies that have been told, that it's gonna take some time to work through. Okay? I said I'll stand by the truth and I'll stand by you with the truth. Gannon's the priority, alright? What's your next yes or no question?

LETECIA STAUCH: Do you have any intentions of being back with your wife and family?

ALBERT STAUCH: No. And it's the same answer, same response as I gave you last time.

Gannon's the priority right now. Alright, here's what we're gonna do. I answered your questions and respected you.

LETECIA STAUCH: No -

ALBERT STAUCH: Hold on, I respected you. I didn't put you through the inquisition. I gave you four yes or no questions and I left it at that. You're not respecting me in that way so I'm gonna go back to question two. You said you were not the last person Gannon was with, so who was? Okay, I answered your questions.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] inquisition questions.

ALBERT STAUCH: No, you got two or three -

LETECIA STAUCH: You said yes or no.



ALBERT STAUCH: Alright, what's - See this is why I don't believe you. I'ma be straight up with you. If you wanna do this polygraph thing, I'm willing to do it and willing to take it at face value but you're not respecting me and still expecting respect in return. You're expecting to play by the rules and you're not playing by the rules.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] your wife [inaudible]

ALBERT STAUCH: Nope, I said damage.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] telling the truth [inaudible]

ALBERT STAUCH: I said there's damage and we gotta repair it, that's all I said. I haven't said anything about anybody to anyone in the media, social media, nothing. And if you got something else then it's false, so.

LETECIA STAUCH: Okay, the next question. Have you filed for divorce?

ALBERT STAUCH: Nope. See, here you go again not playing by the rules.

LETECIA STAUCH: You said yes or no, that's what I said!

ALBERT STAUCH: Yeah, but you got to put me through the inquisition but you're not answering my question. Who was the last person Gannon was with if it wasn't you? 'Cause these are gonna be the questions you're gonna have to answer. I mean, I'm just gonna be straight up with you, whether you answer them to me or not.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible]

ALBERT STAUCH: Well Mr. hot shot Baez will, okay, if you don't. So, we might as well do this peacefully between me and you and figure out where Gannon's at.

LETECIA STAUCH: I've already agreed to the [inaudible]. If I, If I'm - Now, [inaudible] through this, I am gonna have to [inaudible] what happened to him and I have no idea where Gannon's at. Why are you still being adamant that - That's my point. I said [inaudible] you controlling it 'cause you'll still swear up and down -

ALBERT STAUCH: No, if -

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible]

ALBERT STAUCH: But, listen this is pre-polygraph. Polygraph I won't be in the room, probably not even in the building so you're not under any pressure, okay. That's how those things go. It's all you and the guy asking the questions.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] won't even be there either because they [inaudible] interview me with [inaudible] by myself.

ALBERT STAUCH: Right, that's what I'm saying. I won't be there. I'll pick you up, take you, drop you off, pay for it but then I'll bounce, ok. But, you need to answer me this, as your husband and as the father of the missing child.

LETECIA STAUCH: You have no intentions of being my husband.

ALBERT STAUCH: But I still am, am I not? Okay? Point is, who was the last person that had Gannon? You said you weren't, so who was?

[long silence]

ALBERT STAUCH: Hello?

LETECIA STAUCH: I'm gonna tell that to the person. Want me to rephrase that in a yes or no question? Because [inaudible] because no matter what I say to you you're gonna yell at me,

scream at me, hang up, act crazy. You legit told me the other day I'm a murderer, killer, probably had involvement. You told me this, told me that, then told me you don't have any intentions when you find out your wife is not involved to be with her.

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay -

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible]

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay, but did you murder Gannon?

LETECIA STAUCH: That's what your mind is saying -

ALBERT STAUCH: Hey, did you murder Gannon?

LETECIA STAUCH: What?

ALBERT STAUCH: Did you kill Gannon?

LETECIA STAUCH: No!

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay then back to what we said, it had to be an accident. I mean, so you accidentally hurt him, that's - It's either or, you said that already.

LETECIA STAUCH: Why did you ask that? That's one of your questions ain't it?

ALBERT STAUCH: Right.

LETECIA STAUCH: Is that one of your questions? Did I murder -

ALBERT STAUCH: Well, that's two questions but -

LETECIA STAUCH: Here's where I have the problem.

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay.

LETECIA STAUCH: I will pass it and then you're gonna come back to square one and still accuse me because you're gonna say there's damage and all this, you're gonna accuse me of

somehow still being involved. That's what you're gonna do. Right now you can't accept - You have the nerve to say to me, 'I am not gonna be with my wife and family at all, hardly'. If Gannon showed up on the doorstep, today, you're still gonna say that to me.

ALBERT STAUCH: Yeah, yeah fair enough but you know what I'll -

LETECIA STAUCH: Because you're so fuckin' pissed -

ALBERT STAUCH: No, I'm not pissed, I'm hurt. My son's missing. I'm hurt 'cause my son's missing and he's hurt, okay. 'Cause I saw his blood and I know if you thought I knew who took Harley and she was missing and hurt and raped and all these things that have been alleged, okay, you - If you thought I knew that, you'd want me to tell you, too. Okay, you admitted you were not the last person that Gannon was with, so that means you know. At least a description, at least a name, or something. And you're not telling me. And, you need to put yourself -

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] description!

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay, but that description was Quincy Brown, and 15 different stories and you already told me, you already told me. Yeah, it was Eduardo the Mexican guy, right? Or uncle Matt? Here we go again.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] why don't you ask about legit answers.

ALBERT STAUCH: Right, did you kill Gannon? That's a legitimate question.

LETECIA STAUCH: No.

ALBERT STAUCH: Did you accidentally hurt Gannon?

LETECIA STAUCH: You keep asking me like 15 times, like, like you go ahead and get this out your system 'cause I, I'ma -

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay, fine, fine.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] you're gonna be like, 'wow, she passed the test.'

ALBERT STAUCH: Yup. Okay, the bottom line is -

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] Nancy Grace is gonna call my line to do it.

ALBERT STAUCH: Yeah let's call her. Let's call Maury Povich too. He'll help.

LETECIA STAUCH: Call 'em! You've already said tomorrow or whenever you're calling this thing, you've already said that, you said you wanted to do it between me and you because this is for you.

ALBERT STAUCH: No you said that. But the truth is, the truth is you won't tell me who because there is no who and the who is you.

LETECIA STAUCH: How... How... Why. Okay, so. Here you go again. You are not even trusted and that's why I said you could call who it was because you're not even trusting in a lie detector test.

ALBERT STAUCH: No, you sent me a link and you said no to the FBI which is - If I had a choice it'd be the FBI, like -

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] the police department.

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay then I don't have control. I don't have control and I don't have a say so. See, this is where we always get to our relationship.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] somebody in Colorado Springs.

ALBERT STAUCH: I did. There's FBI in Colorado Springs and you got her number.

LETECIA STAUCH: You just told me you were gonna call the other people! I'm not doing the FBI because they're police. I'm doing a lie detector -

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay, so listen -

LETECIA STAUCH: - no, what you call it.

ALBERT STAUCH: Listen, if the who Gannon was last with, if the who was not you, then who is it?

LETECIA STAUCH: You're asking me the same damn question.

ALBERT STAUCH: 'Cause you never answer it, you never answer it.

LETECIA STAUCH: You already made it clear that I'm not your wife. You already made that clear.

ALBERT STAUCH: Actually I, actually I - and I quote, I said, 'you are still my wife,' I just said we don't have a relationship right now because of all this. That's what I said. To be clear -

LETECIA STAUCH: But you're telling me, you're telling me I mean absolutely nothing to you, I'm a piece of crap. That's what you're telling me.

ALBERT STAUCH: Hey, guess what, so this whole - Back to this whole lie detector test bullshit. If you're gonna pass it, who gives a fuck who gives you the lie detector test?

LETECIA STAUCH: I don't want the police involved because -

ALBERT STAUCH: The police are already involved, what are you talking about? But go ahead, I'm sorry.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] trying to [inaudible] picking anybody else besides the police because I want someone who has no reason at all to be involved or anything so that the validity of the test is complete.

ALBERT STAUCH: Yeah, okay.

LETECIA STAUCH: That's all I'm saying.

ALBERT STAUCH: You think the police care about you or me or anything? All these - all they care about whether they're right or wrong -

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] to do it.

ALBERT STAUCH: - all they care about is Gannon.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] is what I'm saying. I'm agreeing like I will do it, I said yes, okay when -

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay, fine, let's do it okay? I said let me pick you up. You wont tell me where you are. I told you all these different things. I tried to do one tomorrow. You said three days from now. 9:00 a.m.

LETECIA STAUCH: I said three times. Three different times is what I said.

ALBERT STAUCH: 9, 9:30, and ten. 9, 9:30, and ten.

LETECIA STAUCH: That's what they had available?

ALBERT STAUCH: That's what I'm gonna tell them, ok.

LETECIA STAUCH: Just call me back and tell me what times they have available.

ALBERT STAUCH: Alright, alright so listen. When I call you back, while you're waiting on me to call you back, I want you to think about this alright, are you ready? Are you ready for this? What happens if you fail this polygraph test? Then what?

LETECIA STAUCH: I'm not gonna fail.

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay, but you need to think about what if you fail?

LETECIA STAUCH: I don't need to think about that. There is no doubt in my mind. Trust me.

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay.

LETECIA STAUCH: I wouldn't be adamant to you, calling you back after you said -

ALBERT STAUCH: You were adamant about Quincy Brown, remember? Until the news reporter, not the polygraph, the news reporter shot that full of shit.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] listen to the person that I care about, the person that I love with everything in me -

ALBERT STAUCH: Do you care about Gannon?

LETECIA STAUCH: You know that.

ALBERT STAUCH: Do you care about Gannon or am I the only one you care about?

LETECIA STAUCH: Of course I care about - I have to care about you first in order to care about our children.

ALBERT STAUCH: Okay, so if you truly care about me, okay. If you truly care about me and all this stuff, all - No listen to me. If you truly care about me and want all this stuff that you tell me every day that you want and send me all these pictures, if all that really means anything to you -



First of all, you sent me a picture without your ring on the other day so that's bullshit, I'm calling bullshit on that.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] ring.

ALBERT STAUCH: Second of all - yeah, then you told me you were wearing them and then you sent me a picture without them. Anyways, so.

LETECIA STAUCH: No, I said, I haven't been wearing my rings, is what I said.

ALBERT STAUCH: Oh, okay.

LETECIA STAUCH: Because the police have confiscated them and you won't help me get any of them back because they were in the car that's in your name that you probably already have back.

ALBERT STAUCH: Yeah I wish. I'm still paying on it by the way and I don't have it. So, just so you know.

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] glad to pay on it, it's her car.

ALBERT STAUCH: And not have it? Right, okay, Uhm, anyways. If you really cared about me -

LETECIA STAUCH: [inaudible] like that.

ALBERT STAUCH: If you really cared about, hey - Let's cut this shit off because this is ridiculous. If you really cared about me you wouldn't've have lied to me 15 times and you wouldn't be lying to me now, okay? And that's it.
