NAME OFFENSE REPORT DATE AND TIME 6/15/2023 5:56:00 PM

On June 15, 2023 at 1616 hours, I responded to 1965 Laurel Lindale Road, Monroe Township, Clermont County for a 911 open line. CAD notes advised there was an open line [REDACTED]. While en route, dispatchers continued to give updates with multiple callers advising there was an active shooter. The shooter was described as a white male wearing a green shirt and blue jeans.

I arrived on scene with Deputy Popham at 1626 hours and deployed my patrol rifle. I observed the male seated on the porch and could hear a female screaming. I began giving the male verbal commands to stand up and walk towards me. I was updated by dispatch that the shooter was named Chad Doerman. At this time, I could see what I believed to be a brown long rifle next to the shooters left hand. Due to the need to assess the injuries to victims, we began to approach Chad and continued giving him verbal commands to stand up. Chad continued to ignore commands and remain seated. After passing a camper in the front yard, I was able to observed three bodies of juvenile boys laying in the front yard [REDACTED]. I continued to approach the shooter and asked Deputy Popham to hold cover for me while I attempted to grab the shooter. I grabbed Chad by the left arm and placed him onto the ground. I secured his hands while Deputy Popham placed handcuffs on.

After Chad was in custody, I ran [REDACTED] and the three juveniles to assess injuries. I informed dispatch that the shooter was in custody and to send in EMS for three children with gunshot wounds. In an attempt to get the kids to medics sooner, I grabbed one and ran towards the roadway. EMS began to arrive on scene. I sat the juvenile down on the ground and began to perform CPR until EMS took over my position. I secured my rifle in my patrol vehicle and went back to gather information. I went back to the scene [REDACTED] to the life squad for a gunshot wound to her left thumb. I made contact with [REDACTED] who said she was the sister of the victims. I obtained her information and provided it to Sergeant Feilhauer. I remained on scene for scene security until detectives arrived on scene.

On 6-19-23 at 1616 hours, I was dispatched to 1965 Laurel Lindale for a 911 open line. [REDACTED] I activated my lights and sirens at this time and responded from SR 125 @ MT Holly. While responding to the scene dispatch was giving updates. They advised that someone was actively shooting at the firehouse. Dispatch stated that the active shooter was a male white wearing green shirt, and wearing blue jeans. They advised that the male was sitting on the porch of 1965 Lauerl Lindale. Dispatch then advised that several small children have been shot and were laying in the front yard.

Deputy Sparks and I arrived at the same time (1626 hours) and we could observed that male sitting on the porch of the residence. We started to give the male verbal commands to stand up and show us his hands. Deputy Sparks and I tried to move down to the driveway to take a better advantage point. We decide to move back up to the cruisers and respond up to the residence. While responding up to the residence we were giving the male verbal commands. When we reached the male I kept cover and Deputy Sparks went hands on. We detained that male (Chad Doerman) and advised EMS to respond to the scene. After detaining the male I stayed with him until Deputy Rudd arrived on scene. I advised Deputy Rudd to secure the male in a patrol car.

After Deputy Rudd took the male, I responded to the front yard of the residence where [REDACTED] was giving [REDACTED] children medical attention. [REDACTED] two of the children and Deputy Sparks picked up one of the children and ran towards EMS. I remained [REDACTED] and assisted with medical attention with one of the children.

Deputy Sparks and I noticed that [REDACTED] had a gunshot wound to the left thumb. We advised EMS and assisted her to the squad. I collected information from [REDACTED] in the back of the squad reference her children.

I remained on scene until detectives arrived on scene.
