General Information

Set -Up sheets and Group Introductions: Please complete and email these to barkerj@pearlandisd.org by Friday, March 22.

Arrival: Plan to arrive at least an hour prior to your performance. Please see the attached exterior map for unloading and bus parking. Representatives from the Pearland High School Band will meet your buses upon arrival, lead you to your holding area, warm-up area and escort you throughout the contest. *The Fine arts gym will be available as a holding area.* All instrument cases will need to remain on the buses.

Traffic: If you are arriving before 7:30 AM or between 2:20-2:45, please allow extra time for before/after school traffic.

The **Contest Office** will be located in the Black Box, which is room 1728, in the hallway behind the stage.

Restrooms will be available next to the Auditorium and athletic hallway (see map) for your students to use when you arrive. No students will be able to enter any other areas of the high school campus for use of restrooms.

Form 1: A certified copy of the Organization Roster Form No. 1 listing in alphabetical order all students eligible the day of the competition must be on file with the region executive secretary prior to the time of each organization's scheduled contest performance.

Scores: Please have three sets of scores numbered for the judges.

Warm-up: Please instruct your students to refrain from playing until you begin your specified warm-up time in the small band hall. There should be no playing in the holding area.

Performance: Your concert performance will occur on stage in the Pearland HS Auditorium. The sight-reading portion of the contest will occur in the large band hall, across the hall from the auditorium.

The Pearland Band will provide the following equipment:

We will have **8** full-size riser platforms available on stage. **4** with 8-inch legs and **4** with 16 inch legs. Risers are NOT available in the sightreading room.

Please bring supplemental risers to compensate for your needs.

Warm-up Room:

Tuner, metronome, and harmony director will be provided in the warmup room.

Parent/Spectator Parking:

Any parents or spectators who will be attending to watch will have to park on the *Visitor Side* of the Rig (see exterior map). Parents will be able to enter at the Percussion Load-in entrance. At that entrance, they will receive a Visitor Pass. *They will NOT need to check in at the front of the school.*
