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General Volunteering

Programs – Chair: Kelly Capps – programs@lespta.com

- Cultural Arts** – *year round* – Volunteers are needed to help coordinate cultural arts events at school.
- Ready to Roar** – *year round* – Volunteers are needed to help welcome new families to LES through various activities and events.
- Spirit Week** – *Fall/Spring* – Volunteers are needed to help with various activities at school throughout the week.
- Book Fairs** – *Fall/Spring* – Each year, LES hosts 2 Book Fairs in our Library to allow our families to shop for their favorite books, and raise money for our Library. Volunteers for this event can assist with setup and closing, and assist students in browsing and purchasing books.
- Field Day** – *May* – Volunteers are needed to manage events on the field. Help is also needed for set up, clean up, maintaining the water station, and other various areas.
