Treasurer's Update	Erin Alton	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The majority of our budget (41%) goes to Staff Support and Mini Grants               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Explained mini grants and provided examples as to what is covered in mini grants</li> </ul> </li> <li>- All the budget information is available on LESPTA.com</li> <li>- Our goal this year is to raise \$76,900</li> <li>- Teacher/School Support:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- \$33,600 - this money stays at the school if that staff member leaves, and if a certain item is purchased with PTA money, it stays at the school as well.</li> </ul> </li> <li>- For the past few years we have carried over a larger surplus than we should have. This year, our goal is to end at the end of the year with only \$11,000.</li> <li>- Erin Alton made a motion to approve the proposed 2023-24 LES PTA Budget, Meredith Schauer seconded it, unanimous approval was made.</li> </ul>
