JOHN 16:12-15: Jesus teaches his disciples about the nature of the Spirit which they are going to receive. He explains that this power of wisdom, discernment and truth is inextricably part of himself, just as he is in the Father and the Father is in him. So, when we open ourselves to the Spirit, we open ourselves to the full force of the Godhead.

JUNE - MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS: This beautiful devotion reminds us how precious we are to the Lord who loves each and every one of us. Let us turn to Him in our prayers,

saying: Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place my trust in you!' O most holy Heart of Jesus, fountain of every blessing, I adore you, I love you, and with a lively sorrow for my sins, I offer you this poor heart of mine. Make me humble, patient, pure, and obedient to your will. Grant, good Jesus, that I may live in you and for you. Protect me in the midst of danger; comfort me in my afflictions; give me health of body, assistance in my temporal needs, your blessings on all that I do, and the grace of a holy death. Within your heart, I place my every care. In every need let me come to you with humble trust saying, Heart of Jesus, help me. Amen. Whenever we feel that everyone ignores us, that no one cares what becomes of us, that we are of no importance to anyone, He remains concerned for us. **Pope Francis' Encyclical Delexit Nos (No. 40)**

DAY FOR LIFE: The Church teaches that life is to be nurtured from conception to natural death. In England and Wales, Day for Life is celebrated on the third Sunday of June each year. This year it falls on 15 June. The theme is Finding meaning in Suffering – Hope does not Disappoint. It is inspired by Romans 5:5-6. St Paul invites us to see that Christian hope is not just naïve optimism but, rather, an unshakeable trust in the power and presence of God who is with us always. This hope can endure the darkness of human suffering and even see beyond it.
