**RECENTLY DEATH:** Joan Gill, may she rest in peace. Please remember her, her family and friends in prayer.

MARK 6:30-34: It is vital for us all to have times of retreat in our heavy schedules, Jesus wisely shepherds his apostles to a lonely place where they can relax, rest and have space. We need to do the same, setting aside some time each week, if possible; it is not laziness, but a valuable recharging of batteries.

Not that the plans always work out, Jesus arrived with apostles at an isolated spot, ready for a time of quietness, only to find crowds of people eager to see him. They had struggled round with all their sick and crippled, hoping for more cures and help. As a human, Jesus' heart must have sunk at the sight of so much need when he was tired; but as God, he lays the tiredness aside in a rush of sympathy, understanding and compassion. They need their good shepherd, and he responds to their need.

A SEMINARIAN: This week, we welcome Johnson Edeh who is a seminarian for our diocese. Johnson will be studying at St. Mary's College, Oscott, in Birmingham, and will be living at St. Mary's in Dukinfield during his

breaks from seminary. When Johnson is living in St. Mary's Dukinfield, he will have some involvement in the day-to-day parish life and activities and so we look forward to getting to know him over the next year or so.

**FOURTH WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY** - Sunday 28th of July 2024. We will celebrate this day in honour of all grandparents and elderly members of our congregation next week. This is the closest Sunday to the feast of St Anne and St Joachim, which we celebrate the Friday before on the 26th of July 2024. Pope Francis has written a message especially for this occasion and the Diocese has created a booklet that includes his message and the prayer prepared for the day.

**POPE'S JULY PRAYER INTENTION: FOR PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:** Pope Francis invites Christians to pray that the Church might show God's closeness to people enduring illness. "Let us pray that the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick grant the Lord's strength to those who receive it and to their loved ones, and that it may become for everyone an ever more visible sign of compassion and hope."

MASS FOR THE SICK AND HOUSEBOUND: We need volunteers to bring people to Mass. Please speak to Fr Isidore. We will be celebrating a Mass for the Sick and Housebound at both our parish churches in August. The Mass intention will be for healing, and the masses will be on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> August at 6:30pm at Paul's, and on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> August at 11am at St Mary's. Everyone is welcome and you can come for physical, emotional, or spiritual healing for yourself or for someone else. Please also get in touch if you would like to attend the Mass, or know someone who would, and need help with transport.

**SVP ADVENTURE HOLIDAY:** As you may know, the SVP in Hyde and Stockport send 40 young children, who would otherwise not have a holiday, on a week's adventure holiday each year, run by SVP volunteers, to a centre in North Wales. As usual, this year approximately half of them are from our catholic schools in Hyde. The cost of the holiday is £17,000 which we have to raise locally each year. Whilst we have raised the funds for this year's holiday, we need to start raising the funds for 2025 as we need to have raised sufficient by the need of the year so that are allowed to commit to the 2025 holiday. There will be a retiring collection this weekend for this purpose, and we would ask you to be as generous as possible so that we can continue this worthwhile activity for our young people. Thank you.
