This will involve, completing assessments, the Wellbeing Scale, documentation and due process in compliance with GDPR, Charity commission, and Evergreen standards and best practice, ensuring Safe, Effective, Caring, Responsive and Well-Led provision. The Befriending Lead will attend relevant events and develop community links that promote the Befriending Service, organise and attend Befriender Induction and volunteer training and attend the monthly All Leads meeting and social events that relate to Befriending e.g. Tea Parties and special events.
