**Salt of the Earth (Matthew 5:13; Galatians 5:22–23)**

**Works of Darkness (John 10:10; Opposites)**

**Preserves life** – holding back decay and corruption

**Destroys life** – spreads corruption and ruin

**Flavors the world** with God’s truth and love

**Poisons the world** with lies and hatred

**Covenant faithfulness** – reflecting God’s holiness

**Unfaithfulness** – breaking covenant, betrayal

**Love** – caring sacrificially for others

**Hatred** – bitterness, cruelty, murder

**Joy** – delight in God and His blessings

**Despair** – sorrow, misery, hopelessness

**Peace** – reconciliation, wholeness, calm spirit

**Conflict & Fear** – strife, division, anxiety

**Patience** – endurance, long-suffering

**Impatience & Rage** – anger, rash actions

**Kindness** – mercy, compassion

**Harshness & Cruelty** – selfishness, abuse

**Goodness** – moral integrity, righteousness

**Corruption & Evil** – greed, dishonesty

**Faithfulness** – loyalty to God and others

**Unfaithfulness** – betrayal, unreliability

**Gentleness** – humility, tender strength

**Pride & Violence** – arrogance, domination

**Self-control** – discipline, mastery over desires

**Indulgence & Addiction** – reckless living

**Brings life abundantly** (John 10:10b)

**Steals, kills, and destroys** (John 10:10a)
