Works of Darkness (John 10:10; Opposites)

Preserves life – holding back decay and corruption

Flavors the world with God's truth and love

Covenant faithfulness – reflecting God's holiness

Love – caring sacrificially for others

Joy – delight in God and His blessings

Peace – reconciliation, wholeness, calm spirit

Patience – endurance, long-suffering

Kindness – mercy, compassion

Goodness – moral integrity, righteousness

Faithfulness – loyalty to God and others

Gentleness – humility, tender strength

Self-control – discipline, mastery over desires

Brings life abundantly (John 10:10b)

Destroys life – spreads corruption and ruin

Poisons the world with lies and hatred

Unfaithfulness – breaking covenant, betrayal

Hatred – bitterness, cruelty, murder

Despair – sorrow, misery, hopelessness

Conflict & Fear – strife, division, anxiety

Impatience & Rage – anger, rash actions

Harshness & Cruelty - selfishness, abuse

Corruption & Evil – greed, dishonesty

Unfaithfulness – betrayal, unreliability

Pride & Violence – arrogance, domination

Indulgence & Addiction – reckless living
