Though I was King, I took the form of a servant.

Though I possessed all authority, I humbled Myself unto death.

The path upward in My Kingdom begins by kneeling.

The greatest among you shall be the servant of all.

When your tongue is tempted to wound, remember that life and death are carried in words.

Let your speech be filled with grace and truth.

Speak as one who has been forgiven.

Speak as one who bears My name.

When anger burns within you, bring your wounds to Me.

Do not carry what I have asked you to surrender.

Forgiveness is not weakness.

It is strength placed in the hands of God.

I see every injustice.

I will judge rightly.

Trust Me with what you cannot repair.

When fear surrounds you, remember who walks beside you.

The winds obey My voice.

The seas obey My command.

The future you fear is already known to Me.

Do not let your heart be troubled.

Believe in God.

Believe also in Me.

When comfort calls you away from obedience, remember that you were created for more than ease.

You were called to follow Me.

The path may be difficult.

But the destination is glorious.

Do not trade eternal reward for temporary comfort.

And when your allegiance is tested, remember the First Commandment.

Love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength.

Not because I seek control over you.

Because I alone am worthy of your worship.

Everything else will eventually fail you.

I never will.

The enemy seeks a divided heart.

I seek your whole heart.

The enemy asks, 'What do you desire?'

I ask, 'Will you follow Me?'

The enemy points you toward self.

I point you toward the Father.

The enemy promises a crown without a cross.

I carried the cross so that you might share in My crown.

Take courage.

The battle is real.

The temptations are real.

But My victory is also real.

I have overcome the world.

I have broken the power of sin.

I have defeated death.

I have crushed the serpent's head.

Stand firm, therefore.

Put on the full armor of God.

Walk in truth.

Walk in holiness.

Walk in humility.

Walk in love.

Walk in faith.

Walk in obedience.

And when you stumble, rise again.

For I am faithful.

When you are weak, I am strong.

When you call upon Me, I will hear you.

You are not fighting for victory.
