

**Project Description** 


- · Approximately 2,000 acres in unincorporated Maricopa County 30 miles west of the Town of Gila Bend
- · Phased approach with first phase to begin in 2024 or later
- Up to 800-megawatt photovoltaic solar array utilizing single-axis tracking that includes battery storage
- · Adjacent to existing electrical infrastructure reducing environmental impacts associated with additional infrastructure
- Provide clean, renewable energy to the region and increase water conservation
- Closely working with landowners and stakeholders toward the project's success





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
