

Scrapbook 2025-2026

The scrapbook is a pictorial history of your Unit's activities. Keep in mind that it is a permanent record, so prepare it using acid free paper, ink and supplies. The rules listed may seem complicated, but if they are followed correctly, the result will be a scrapbook your Unit will be proud of.

There will be 3 categories to be judged at Convention in June. (1) Traditional (from Emblem Sales/National) (2) Non-traditional (your choice of size and/or binder) (3) Junior Auxiliary.

Requirements For Judging In All Categories:

1. Entries must be contained within a scrapbook or binder.

2. **TITLE PAGE:** The first page of the scrapbook, with the information centered. Name and Unit number, location. (Optional: a picture of the Post may also be used)

3. Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag

4. **Auxiliary Preamble** It is worth the money to purchase a copy of the Preamble from Emblem Sales catalog. It is time-saving, it makes an attractive page, and it will fit either size scrapbook. However, other copies are acceptable as long as they are neatly centered on the page.

5. **TABLE OF CONTENTS:** This table consists of the sections of the scrapbook, and each section must be listed with a title and page number for quick reference. It must be in numerical order, so it is one of the last page(s) to complete, along with the index for the end of the scrapbook. Page numbers must be lined up neatly on the right side, using dots between the titles and page numbers to make the job easier, if you like.

PAGE NUMBERING WILL START WITH THE TITLE PAGE

EXAMPLE:

TITLE PAGE.....	1
PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.....	2
PREAMBLE.....	3
TABLE OF CONTENTS.....	4,5

6. Next photo of the Unit President, with her name underneath, positions held. (Not to exceed 5 x 7)

7. Any members that hold/held National, District, Department offices.

8. **OFFICERS:** List unit officers and chairmen. Use and installation photo, a group photo, or cameos of each.

9. Start filling your scrapbook in chronological order with events your Unit has held or attended with Title at top of page the event, date and place. Any newspaper or magazine article can be used if your members attended, please try to use names under your photos, we may remember but as time goes on others may not.

If youth photos are used please try to only use first names as to protect our youth's innocents from those who should ask to see scrapbooks.

10. President Biniecki theme this year is : "We Are Family" as well as America will turn 250 years old Please designate a page each to show her appreciation. Can be anywhere in the scrapbook. But will be judged that it is there.

11. Last Page: The last page should include a photo of the SCRAPBOOK chairman (Compiler) her name, address, and unit name/number. All members who assisted should sign the page.

Please do not hesitate to call or email for any clarification or questions you may have.

Judging will be done on the historic value, usefulness, neatness, and attractiveness of the scrapbook.

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
