**"What Makes Kawaiaha'o a Wahi Pana?"**



*"Wahi Pana:* In Hawaiian, the term for a sacred place is wahi pana. Wahi is the word for place. In isolation, the word pana means "pulse." Thus, sacred places are "places with a pulse," living space." - Na Wahi Pana O Hawaii: Sacred Places of Hawaii, Okura/Hallen

Journey back to the time of our Ali'i to understand the historical significance of what makes this site sacred, the spot that was selected for the settling of the Christian missions, and the site for the first Christian Church on O'ahu.
