Summarizing GENESIS

I want to do a quick summary of the 66 books of the Bible each week. This overview will hopefully help you in your daily devotions and your bible studies to see what is covered in each book. The Old Testament took a little over a thousand years to write and was being compiled around 400 B.C.

Hebrew was a semitic language spoken in the North African peninsula and into the Middle East. The Israelites spoke it a long time ago. However, when Judah was invaded and taken over by Babylon, which I had preached on from Books like Habakkuk and Daniel, the Jews began to speak Aramaic. Unfortunately the Hebrew language died except for those Jews who studied the religious books. Why I bring this up is because Hebrew is the one and only dead language that has ever been restored to a living language, mainly because of the Bible. The Bible was written in three languages; Biblical Hebrew - which is very different from Modern Hebrew, Aramaic, and Ancient Greek which is no longer spoken today.

The Book of **Genesis** is the first book of the Bible. Genesis is a Greek word meaning creation. As we know, the Book begins with the creation of the world. Throughout this Book we read stories of people like Adam and Eve in the garden, their sons Cain who killed his brother Abel, the evil of mankind who God chose to swallow up in a giant flood and the Ark built by Noah and his 'ohana, the tower of Babel and God scattering the people by giving them different languages to speak, the story of Abram who is renamed Abraham who would become the father of many nations, God destroying the two cities of Sodom and Gomorrah, the story of Abraham and Sarah's son Isaac who marries Rebekah and has twins named Esau and Jacob, how Jacob robs his brother of his birthright, how Jacob has nine sons and his youngest at the time was sold to traders who take him to Egypt. This Book ends with this story of Joseph whose disastrous young life was used by God for the good of God's people. In the end Jacob blesses all his sons and dies.


Sunday, August 23, 2020


