Speaker Rachel Kaiama is the daughter of Everett and Millicent Kalei Kaiama of Waimea Hawai‘i. A second generation Hawaiian rancher’s offspring, she grew up in Kuhio Village Homestead and currently lives at Kalāwahine Homestead in Honolulu. As a kaikamahine, Rachel attended Imiola Church with her Papa George and Grandma Tsuji and she is an active member at Kawaiaha‘o. She is a worshipper with Hālau Hula ‘O Kawaiaha‘o and the vice moderator of the Church. Her love for Ke Akua and His "word" encourages her life-journey to share GOD's love with HIS people during her travels and on prayer-missions to Papua New Guinea, Israel, and last year to New England to honor the beloved Henri ‘Ōpūkaha‘ia and to commemorate the departure of the missionaries from Boston 200 years ago. Besides hula, and the outdoors, Rachel loves poetry and music and works at the University of Hawai‘i, Shidler College, School of Travel Industry Management.
