- Snowplow operations will be limited to ISLA common roadways.
- Vehicle maintenance and fuel is covered by HOA fees.
- Snowplow operations do not include private driveways, due to safety and insurance concerns.
- Long private roadways are subject to driver judgement as this is a safety issue.
- Typically, after a snowfall of 6" +/-, we will be plowing the common ISLA roads, leaving 1-2" on
  the road so the blade never touches the surface. This helps with road grading and plow life.
   Typical hazardous spots where melting is slow will be plowed closer to the road surface in the
  coldest winter months.
- Decision to plow will be at the discretion of the coordinator, based on actual road and weather conditions.
- Drivers and coordinators are ISLA volunteers, be sure to thank them.
- Expect winter mountain conditions. Good snow tires, good ground clearance, 4WD/AWD vehicles, and/or tire chains recommended.
