

At the December luncheon, we will be collecting canned and packaged goods for a local food bank. So please remember to bring along some items to help those in need. The number of hungry families in our area continues to grow.

Soon after, some of our fellow retirees and their families will depart the Port of Baltimore for a New Year's Cruise to the Caribbean. *Bon voyage,* Enchantment of the Seas! Take lots of photos, travelers, because we'd love to share some of them in the next Hot Flashes.

Your Board has already started planning next year's activities. The Retirees Association will host the 3rd annual <u>Information for Seniors Fair</u> on Wednesday, May 15, 10 AM – 2 PM. (This event will replace the KIT luncheon that would normally take place that day). As you know, numerous organizations attend our event to share information that might be of interest to seniors in general, and to our retirees in particular. Past participants have included County agencies (such as the Retirement Office and the Benefits staff from the Department of Human Resources), private insurance providers, Fairfax County Credit Union, Everly Funeral Home, and a representative of the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute, among others. INOVA generously provides free health screenings and general information about common health conditions, such as diabetes and hypertension. We even have some retiree entrepreneurs selling their wares! We plan to make next year's event even better. We are exploring the possibilities of providing free "bulk shredding while you wait" for attendees (so you can have old papers destroyed without having to worry about identity theft) and a means of getting rid of old medicines without polluting the environment.
