The COVID-19 pandemic forced the closure of the UNITE Cultural Center, but AWOKE used the opportunity to innovate and continued program efforts virtually. The GR818ERS hosted the world's first virtual international street dance campaign and livestream competition which reached over 15,000 people globally.

AWOKE served as the West Valley Co-Chair of the SFV Complete Count Committee which sought to promote Census 2020. In addition to pop-up outreach events, the West Valley Subcommittee organized a Census Car Caravan of over 30 vehicles to focus efforts in Canoga Park's hard-to-count communities.

At the height of the social uprising, The GR818ERS convened community members to dialogue and organize around public safety reform, including serving as a foundational member of CAT 911 SFV which seeks to establish and promote community alternatives to law enforcement.

Through their continued involvement as a Core Member of the Invest in Youth Coalition, AWOKE's Executive Director and Intern Coordinator were appointed to the City of LA's Executive Task Force on Youth Development to develop a roadmap for the establishment of the City's inaugural Youth Development Department.

AWOKE supported the relief and recovery of local nonprofit organizations though their leadership in the Campaign for Nonprofit Resilience and ongoing participation in Alliance United, a collaborative of Northeast SFV nonprofits focused on integrating Anti-Racism principles and practices.



We resolve to continuing our foundational work of improving racial and human relations in the Greater Los Angeles County and globally through arts, athletics, and activism. We commit to holding safe, brave spaces at the UNITE Cultural Center and beyond to heal trauma, organize against injustice and build community. As one of our youth leaders exclaimed, "THIS IS HISTORY! It's our time to use our voice and serve our community."








PROGRAM TIMELINE






