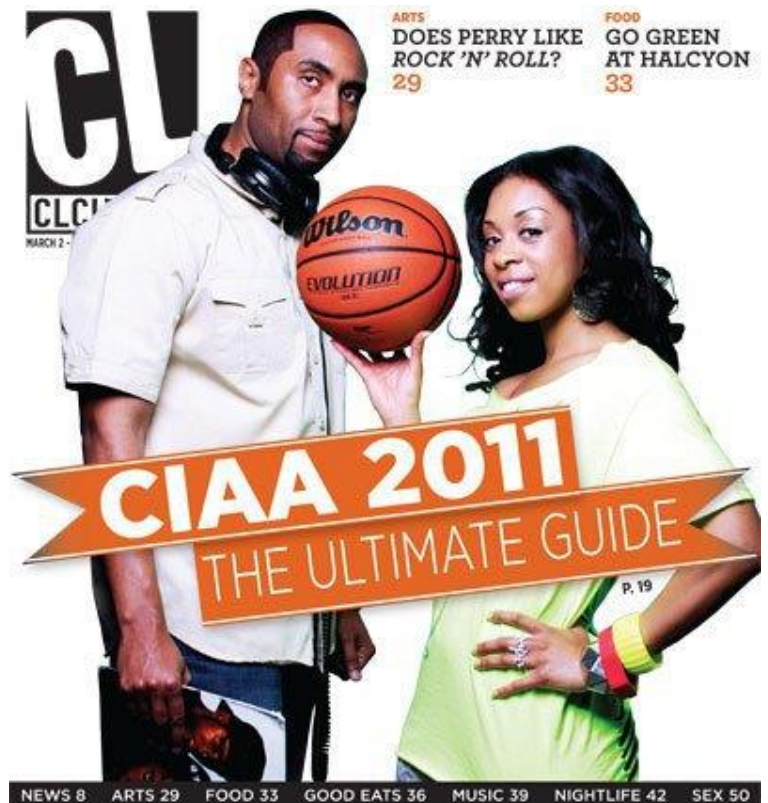


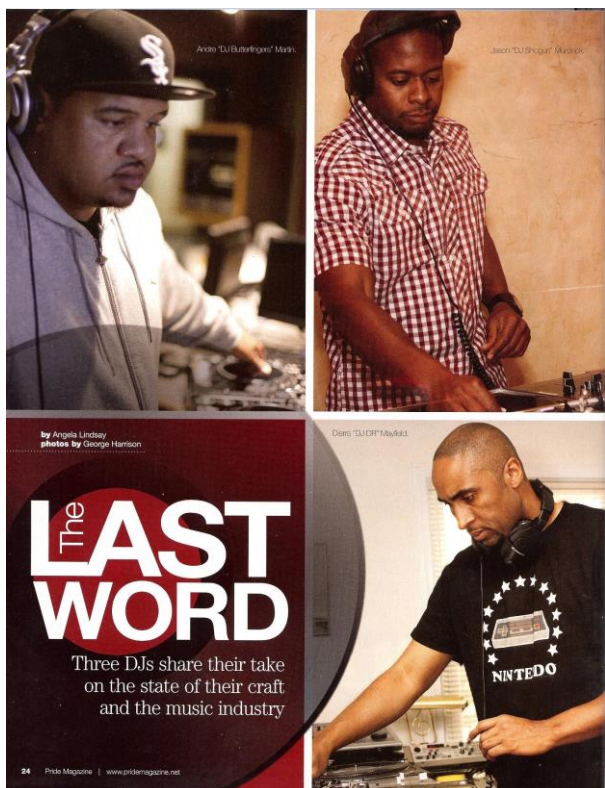

## BIOGRAPHY

The Mighty DJ DR was born in Philadelphia, PA. He was raised in Charlotte, NC since age 9 and fell in love with classic soul music at age 15 when he stumbled across his dad's old school record collection in the shed behind the house. From that point forward DR's life changed! The Mighty DJ DR has shined and been noted as one of the hardest working Professional DJ/producers in the Charlotte area since the early 90's. In, 1999 DR began his first DJ gig in a club at age 25 with real vinyl records. From there he became a Professional resident DJ for countless Charlotte Clubs and Venues, along with events such as the birth of First Fridays. He was a DJ in the backcourt lounge for The Charlotte Bobcats 2009 Basketball season. He performed at various private events during the 2012 Democratic National Convention, as well as countless other weddings, galas, fundraisers and corporate events in and around the Charlotte area. He has been published on the front cover of Creative Loafing (pictured right) as the go to DJ for the 2011 CIAA Basketball Tournament and noted as must see DJ each consecutive year. He also won Creative Loafing's 2011 Club DJ of the year People's Choice. Other publications include Charlotte Pride (pictured below) and PLAY Magazines.





DJ DR served as a member of the now defunct group Katskillz Project. Then most recently the recording group The Others, where the group was signed to Undercover Records, an Independent record label in France.
