Please remain seated during each and every number. No Food or Drink in Auditorium No Photography or Videography All cell phones on silent If you need to exit the auditorium, please do so between dances only unless an emergency or crying little one. If you know that you will be making several trips in and out of the auditorium, it is best to sit somewhere near the aisle. As a courtesy, do not talk during the recital. Though that may not be your child on stage at that particular time, she or he is someone's dancer.
