Stage Make-Up

Stage makeup is required for Stage Rehearsal and Recital Performance. Do your best on our little dancers. This will prevent their faces from washing out under the bright stage lights.

Makeup needed:

Foundation: One shade darker than dancer's skin tone

Face Powder: To set foundation

Eye Shadow: Dark Brown (Contour), Med Earth tone (definition), Crème (Highlight)

Eye Liner: Black

Mascara: Black (Waterproof)

Brow Pencil: Same as hair color

Lip Liner: Red **Lip Stick:** Warm Red / Berry Red

Blush/ Rouge: Berry / Pink

***Parents:** Just do your best with your young dancer.

(Blush, Lipstick, Swipe of Thick, Black Waterproof Mascara=Top Priority)

Stage Rehearsal: Recital T-shirt, Plain Black Leggings, Black Cami or Leotard underneath, Dance Shoes for each dance, Hair Slicked Up into a High Bun, Stage Make-Up

Recital: Recital Costumes, Recital Tights, Clean and Hole Free Dance Shoes, Stage Make-Up, Please follow Costume Detail Sheet for each dance

Though that may not be your child on stage at that particular time, she or he is someone's dancer.
