Annual Meeting Summary

The Southeastern Society of Parasitologists held its annual meeting, April 20-22, 2023, at the Richard A. Gillespie College of Veterinary Medicine. The meeting was hosted by Lincoln Memorial University faculty Barbara Shock, Vina and Charles Faulkner of the Local Arrangements Committee. Dr. Christopher Cleveland, President, presided over the Executive Committee. Dr. Elizabeth Gleim as President-elect served as Program Officer and organized the scientific program discussing a diverse spectrum of topics interesting to parasitologists ranging from cestodes in Mongolian shrews to cracking the genetic code of Sarcoptid mites in American Black Bear and everything in between. She also presided over the Business meeting as incoming President. Kristina Hill-Spanik, Vice President and Chair of Student Awards Committee organized judges and oversaw the assessments that resulted in awards for best Graduate Student Presentation (Byrd-Dunn), best Undergraduate Student Presentation (Ciordia-Stewart-Porter).

Approximately 70 people registered for the meeting that included 48 oral presentations and 8

posters of which 66% were presented by students. The Byrd-Dunn Award named in honor of founding members of the Society, Elon E. Byrd (Univ of GA) and Mary C. Dunn (Middle TN State Univ) was presented to Triet Truong, Auburn Univ, Auburn AL for his presentation entitled "Description, life cycle of a new species of Proterometra (Digenea: Azygiidae) from the Cahaba River Alabama USA and phylogenetic analyses". Zoe Von Holten, Middle Georgia State Univ, Macon GA received the Enrique "Rick" Ciordia-Bonner Stewart-Dale Porter Award for her presentation entitled "Revealing diversity of the Diplostomidae (Digenea) parasites in kingfishers". The Ciordia-Stewart-Porter Award honors their contributions in parasitology and support of the Southern Conference on Animal Parasites and Animal Disease Research Workers of the Southern States. Catherine Smith. Univ of Georgia, Athens was recognized with the Poster Award for Abomasal parasites in white-tailed deer.

Dr. Sharon Patton (President SSP 1981, ASP 2002; SSP Meritorious Service Award 1996) received the "SSP President's Award" in recognition for her

32-year legacy of service, support, and mentorship to the Society and its membership. She is the 2nd recipient recognized with this prestigious award having previously been presented in 1986 to Dr. Mary C. Dunn, Charter Member and founding Secretary-Treasurer of SSP.


