## Lesson for Tuesday, September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022

Ok, now on to the lesson at hand tonight.

Just a note before we begin - What does the word **GRACE** – in scripture mean?

Who can tell me the opposite of Grace?

What was the *uniqueness* of the Apostle Paul's ministry?

We have discussed in the past the importance of this ministry to the church – What do you remember about it?

Starting tonight We will be looking at the *Judgments* listed in scripture.

First may I say that there is a common opinion within the church that the millennium (1000 year reign) is to be ushered in by the preaching of the gospel – and after the millennium there is to be a GENERAL RESURRECTION – followed by a General Judgment, and then the earth is to be destroyed by fire.

BELOVED, THIS IS NOT SCRIPTURAL

The reason this is untrue is; scripture talks about one judgment as being in the AIR, another on the EARTH, and a third in HEAVEN.

Listed references are; <u>(air)</u> 1 thes 4:16&17- 2 Cor 5: 6-10 (<u>earth</u>) Matt; 25: 31-46 <u>**READ**</u> <u>**THIS**</u> and (<u>Heaven</u>) Rev: 20: 11-15 <u>**READ THIS**</u>

What is another word for the word Judgments?

Romans 8:1

We will view JUDGMENTS from several aspects.

There are 5 general aspects of Judgments.

We will look at each one.

They are The **subjects** (1)– the **time (2)**– the **place (3)**the **Basis** (4)of Judgment and the **results (5)** 

The first Judgment - #1 is regarding **SIN** 

Very very important we understand this.

Regarding the *subjects* – this first judgment is for the **entire world**.

Famous verse – John 3:16 - However as important a verse is John 3:18

Again – many times you have heard me say this – 2 kinds of folks in the world.

Believers go to heaven – unbelievers do not – simple as that - However both still sin.

There is no 3<sup>rd</sup> program. Everyone falls into one of these 2

What was the time of this judgment?- A.D. 30

From the cross – Jesus cried out "my God, my God why have thou forsaken me?

From the O.T. - Moses lifted up the serpent on the pole - John 3:14

## Numbers 21 7-9 (read it)

Regarding the **Place –** Calvary or Golgotha (Greek word) located immediately outside of Jerusalem walls – near the city – outside the city gates Matt 27:33 & following-

Regarding the **Basis** of the Judgment

This is very important – the Basis of the Judgment is the "finished work of Jesus Christ.

There is nothing to be added to His finished work.

It cannot be improved upon - added to or taken away -

Christ cried out from the Cross – It is finished. What did He mean?

Found only in the Gospel of John.

Accounting term meaning "Paid in full"

The debt owed to His Father – was paid in fll – wiped completely clean – never to be discussed again – Jesus wiped it away

## Read John 17:4 - Luke 19:10 Romans 3:23-25

Then 2<sup>nd</sup> Cor 5:18-19

From the "seed" who would "crush" the serpents head of Genesis 3 to the suffering servant of Isaiah 53 – It is finished

What else was "finished" at the cross? The sufferings He felt, His perfect obedience to the Father - John 5:30 and the "flaming arrows of the evil one **Eph 6:16** and those of us are now "alive with Christ – **Eph 2:1-5** 

## THIS JUDGMENT IS PAST AND OUR PROOF TEXT IS ROMANS 10:4

Christ is the end of the law and its punishment to all who believe.

Romans 8: 1 John 5:24 - We who believe have passed from death - to life.
