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MUSICAL MOVEMENT SYNOPSIS 7: "SUPERHEROES GONE SOUR"

SEL Topic Addressed: Relationship Skills

- I. The ability to establish and maintain healthy and rewarding relationships with diverse individuals and groups.
- II. The ability to communicate clearly, listen well, cooperate with others, resist inappropriate social pressure, negotiate conflict constructively, and seek and offer help when needed.

STYLE OF SONG:

- EDM style beat with fast rapping.
- Think of music by producer Pitbull and rapper Flo Rida.
- Lyric concepts of "Lift up" & "Lift off," essentially drawing connections to superhero powers.

STYLE OF MOVEMENT:

- Invent a "super hero" style dance move based on a secret superhero hand shake called, "The Helpshake"

PERFORMERS STYLING:

- Child actors and dancers dressed like modern day superheroes.
- Brightly colored clothing and shoes.
- Props like superhero masks, capes, shiny shirts, oversized watches, giant gold medallions that say, "Save the Day."

SCENE:

- Sunny day with bright white clouds and bright blue sky.
- City scene, playground scene, skyscraper scene.
- Children flying around, stopping (non-serious) problems and saving the day.

MESSAGE:

- Sound bite: Super friends can save the day
- You can establish and maintain healthy and rewarding relationships with diverse individuals and groups.
- You can develop the ability to communicate clearly, listen well, cooperate with others, resist inappropriate social pressure, negotiate conflict constructively, and seek and offer help when needed.

**TREATMENT:****Intro 1:10**

- The Music starts to play and the screen shows 5-7 child actors in cool superhero style outfits descending from the sky.
- When the child actors land they congregate together and do a secret handshake (part of the The Helpshake dance move), as a greeting to one another.

**Message 0:30**

- One at a time, thought bubbles emerge around the heads of the superhero children.
- The thought bubbles display different memes where children are helping each other. At the end of each heartwarming thought the bubble pops.
- The memes are real life examples of children helping each other but they are entertaining and funny, (two kids washing a dog and getting soaking wet, one child learning to toboggan and falling off, while another child helps them, etc.).

**Dance Move Tutorial 1:00**

- The beat drops and the dancers teach the audience, "The Helpshake," dance move (comprised of the earlier superhero handshake greeting and some cool body moves that make a person look like they are pretending to fly).
- At the end of the sequence the superhero characters float up out of the screen doing super hero poses.
