RESIDENTIAL HEAT PUMP WATER HEATER REBATE PROGRAM General Information

HOMES THAT QUALIFY FOR A REBATE

- New Construction Homes qualify for one HPWH per residence.
- Site Built Homes & Manufactured Homes qualify for one HPWH per existing residence replacing an electric water heater.

REBATE AMOUNT

- \$300 rebate for any qualifying tank size Tier 1.
- \$600 rebate for any qualifying tank size Tier 2 – 3.
- Rebate(s) will not exceed 70% of total heat pump water heater cost and will not cover the cost of installation.

INSTALLER REQUIREMENTS

- For information about how to install the heat pump water heater visit hotwatersolutionsnw.org.
- The HPWH must be installed within six months of the pre-approval date. If the installation exceeds the six-month time frame, the consumer must reapply.

BEFORE INSTALLATION: PRE-APPROVAL

- An on-site visit is *not* required prior to installation to qualify for the rebate.
- You or your contractor must submit the HPWH Rebate Application to Columbia Basin Electric Cooperative before installation to verify that the model qualifies for the rebate.
- Required information for pre-approval: household information, installation information (brand, model, size, installation location, conditioned/unconditioned, home type).
- Pre-approval takes approximately one business day.

AFTER INSTALLATION: FINAL DOCUMENTATION

- You or your contractor must submit a completed Heat Pump Water Heater Rebate Application and final invoice to CBEC email rebates@esgroupllc.com or fax to: 503-344-6942 or to the mailing address on the CBEC HPWH rebate application.

QUALITY ASSURANCE INSPECTION

- CBEC may do a follow-up inspection of your new Heat Pump Water Heater.
- If you are chosen for an inspection, you will be contacted beforehand to schedule a day/time with a CBEC field representative.

CONSUMER REBATE CHECKS

- After CBEC receives your complete application and final invoice, it takes approximately 8 to 10 weeks for rebate checks to be issued and mailed.

All work must meet Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) and CBEC program installation requirements.
