Target Audience

The Ultrasound Wilderness Adventure Race was created to “*explore new frontiers in ultrasound education*” by taking ultrasound education outdoors. An emphasis is placed on innovative and novel ultrasound applications, in order to expose the audience to POCUS concepts that explore beyond what is taught at traditional ultrasound courses.

Event Format

Teams of up to 10 participants are given a handheld POCUS device and a map and must navigate to stations around the island to solve a combination of wilderness medicine and emergency ultrasound objectives.
