- **Vietnam War Museum**

- Charles Bogle was not on the Zoom call but Dale reported that the tornado that touched down in Mineral Wells caused cosmetic damage to the facility. Outdoor displays had extensive damage. The Th-55 and OH-23 Helicopters located at the gate entrance of Ft, Wolters were not damaged. There was extensive damage to the post housing and buildings.

- **Golden History Museum (GHM)**

- The GHM wants to salute Colorado/Golden area Vietnam veterans in light of the 50 years since the end of the Vietnam war. GHM is proposing September for the opening of the Vietnam Veterans Exhibit. It will be in place 6-12 months.
- The GHM is accepting loans or gifts of Vietnam Artifacts, Bio Books, etc for the exhibit.
- A large garrison flag folding event at GHM was canceled for June. Although ceremonies will be held at the City Council chambers to celebrate the 250th Independence Day Anniversary. We are still invited if you want to attend.

- **Wings Over The Rockies (WOR)**

- Terry Olson reviewed the docent list for the Memorial Day weekend at WOR. The HWM schedule for Sunday morning is moved to 1200. Sweet Sioux will be open for docent duty.
- Bob Harris noted WOR charged \$150 to two high school students doing an interview of a VVA member and B-1 bomber pilot for their school project.

- **Wind Crest (July 9)**

- Terry Olson will send a docent sign up sheet to chapter members.
- A recon of the Wind Crest area needs to be completed. Terry volunteered to do the recon.
- Al Harinck said that there will be a large turn out and maybe the HWM should be in place for another day.

- John Hagleroad wanted to know what members planned on attending the VHPA reunion in Louisville, KY on August 5-8. Five members are planning to attend.
- Greg Mann is researching recording member interviews, oral histories at a future date. These interviews will be posted on the new Kiosk that Greg has developed.
- Dale noted that the Firestone Charter School activity went well with over 80 students going through the HWM.
- The HWM new vinyl depiction of the Huey with the Coors rocket pod is completed.
