Old Business:

David Erickson gave a detailed report on the club house roof. It was calked and secured temporarily. David is going to check into sealing the roof with a membrane and possibly rescrewing the tin on the roof. A brief discussion was held about the floor. The club house needs to be lifted and re-leveled and concrete poured. Topic tabled.

Discussion about potential grants was brought to the club. David explained that "A.I." grants may be a possibility. Trynity Prichard has knowledge of the process. Patti Triplett will get "Angie's" phone number from David to check into future grants.

Mark Cook reported that the arena and grounds has been winterized. The arena has had trenches dug in various areas to help expedite the drainage process for the winter thaws and heavy spring rains.

New Business:

Lisa Hawkins reported that she has dates set for the 2024 summer barrel and pole series.

Michelle Stedham will be hosting Monday night play nights again this year. No report was given at the time.

On Sundays throughout the winter months, the youth riding club has the arena reserved at the Lewiston Roundup Grounds from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. This time has been generously sponsored by the Lewiston Roundup Grounds. This is youth riding only. The reserved time is not for adults.

Lisa Hawkins is sending out renewal letters for our sign board Sponsors.

Rena Cook is sending out renewal letters for the Jr. Rodeo Sponsors.

David Erickson is re-doing and updating the roping chutes. He will keep us posted as the weather improves. He is planning on Tuesday night youth practices again this year and will offer live cattle with the approval of the stock provider when available.

There was a brief discussion about the cookshack for this upcoming season. The royalty families ran the cookshack for 2023 and were completely exhausted by the end of the year. We will accept all suggestions for food service for 2024.

Playground: Supervision needs to be increased for the playground equipment. There have been

a few older children playing in the area at events and things are getting broken. Karen Parvin proposed an age limit of 10 and under and perhaps a height limit.

Bi-laws: Any bi-law changes must be posted 3 times in print to the general membership before it can be voted on for a bi-law change.

Membership fees: Karen Parvin made a motion to propose a membership bi-law change. David Erickson 2nd the motion. Motion passed to post the proposed bi-law change.

Official bi-law proposal change:

“When a minor “child” turns 20 as on January 1st, they will be required to have their own adult membership regardless of where they reside.”

Lisa Hawkins is working with Avista and Crow electric to get a bid for new arena lights. She will report back when she has more information.

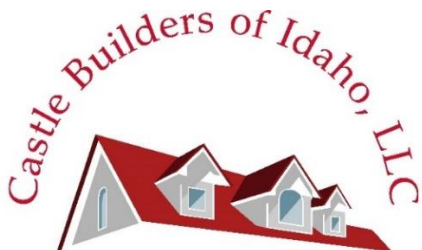

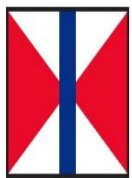

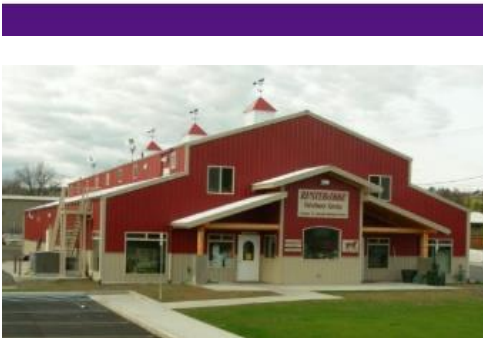
