

LOCAL RULES

RULE 1 - OUT OF BOUNDS

A ball is out of bounds over any boundary wall or fence; in the marked area below and to the left of the 2nd green, extending behind the 6th tee; beyond the board to the rear of the 5th green following a line from the stream to the steps marked by white markers; in or over the grip continuing from the steps up to the 8th tee; on the tarmacadam drive beyond and below the 1st green; on the old clubhouse area, patio and garden; on the new clubhouse, patio and the garden in front; in the marked area beyond the 6th green.

RULE 2

The gardens behind the 1st green and below the 1st tee are G.U.R as is the marked area below the 2nd green and in front of the garage. Without penalty, the ball must be lifted and played from the nearest point of relief or dropping zone if marked, (free relief under Rule 16.1)

RULE 3

A ball lying near any boundary wall or fence may be deemed unplayable and lifted under penalty of one stroke (Rule 19.2 1, 2 or 3).

RULE 4

When playing any hole, the pond and the whole stream are red penalty areas. You may play the ball as it lies, (no penalty), or take penalty relief under Rule 17.1d (1), (2) or (3). Additionally, for the stream penalty areas, you may take penalty relief by dropping a ball on the opposite side of the stream, provided it is no nearer the hole than the original reference point.

RUI F

Concrete tees, steps, seats, grates, drains and banded trees are immovable obstructions (free relief under Rule 16.1).

RULE 6

A player must play from the green matted tee areas of the hole played with or without a tee peg.

RULE 7

Paths and bridges are an integral part of the course, (no free relief).

RULE

Players are only entitled to prefer their lie when the committee has posted an appropriate notice. The notice will describe where and how the lie may be preferred.
