Tulips



Tulipa 'Amazing Parrot'

A flamboyant parrot tulip bursting with lively color and ruffled edges—perfect as a garden showpiece or dramatic cut flower.

Height: ~20"

Flower Color/Form: Bright orange-red fringed, parrot-style petals

Light Requirements: Full sun to part shade Bloom Time: Late spring (Late April–May)



Tulipa 'Black Parrot'

A dramatic, velvet-textured tulip ideal for statement beds or cutting.

Height: ~20-22"

Flower Color/Form: Dark maroon-black with green tones ruffled parrot petals

Light Requirements: Full sun to part shade Bloom Time: Late spring (Late April–May)



Tulipa 'Hakuun' (Darwin hybrid 'White Cloud')

Elegant and dependable, this pure-white Darwin hybrid is excellent for heatprone regions and long-lasting arrangements.

Height: 18-20"

Flower Color/Form: Pure, long-lasting white blooms; heat tolerant

Light Requirements: Full sun; tolerates heat Bloom Time: Mid spring (Mid–Late April)



Tulipa Mayflower 'Menton'

A soft pinky bloom that blooms into the spring show into late season—ideal in containers or borders to prolong floral interest.

Height: ~18-20"

Flower Color/Form: Soft pastel or white blooms; late spring timing

Light Requirements: Full sun to part shade Bloom Time: Very late spring (Early May)

Tulips



Tulipa fosteriana 'Orange Emperor'

One of the earliest bold orange tulips—its radiant blooms atop sturdy stems bring instant color to spring landscapes and arrangements.

Height: 15"

Flower Color/Form: Vivid orange, early-season Fosteriana cups

Light Requirements: Full sun to part shade Bloom Time: Early spring (Early April)



Tulipa 'Rainbow Mix' Variety Blend

An economical way to achieve a stunning, rainbow display in your garden. Bulk format ensures vibrant spring color throughout bloom season.

Height: ~18-20"

Flower Color/Form: A vibrant blend of red, yellow, purple, pink, white—

designed for large, cheerful displays Light Requirements: Full sun to part sun

Bloom Time: Mixed bloom times: early to late spring



Tulipa 'Riesling Whites' Variety Blend

A sophisticated hybrid blend offering elegant whites & greens with varied petal forms—ideal in cut gardens and refined spring schemes.

Height: ~14-18"

Flower Color/Form: White and green petals fringed, double, and classic forms

Light Requirements: Full sun to part shade

Bloom Time: Early spring (Early April)

Tulip Tips

After your tulips bloom in the spring, feel free to snip off the faded flowers, but be sure to leave the leaves in place until they've yellowed and withered. That green foliage is hard at work helping your tulip bulbs store up energy for next year!

Daffodils



Narcissus 'Classic Yellow'

The archetype of spring daffodils—a dependable, cheery bloomer that brightens any landscape with classic yellows.

Height: 14-16"

Flower Color/Form: Bright, sunshine yellow petals and trumpet

Light Requirements: Full sun to part shade

Bloom Time: Early spring (Late March–Early April)

Pest Resistance: Deer/rodent resistant



Narcissus 'Double Duo'

A dreamy double blend in soft pinks and whites; ideal for pastel-themed borders or as low-maintenance showpieces in containers.

Height: 12-16"

Flower Color/Form: Blend of white-centered doubles with pink and yellows

Light Requirements: Full sun to part shade

Bloom Time: Early spring (Late March–Early April)

Pest Resistance: Deer/rodent resistant



Narcissus 'Double Replete'

Mid-spring elegance in a double-headed package; excellent for fresh-cut bouquets and naturalizing with returning reliability.

Height: 15"

Flower Color/Form: Double blooms with white outer petals and pink centers

Light Requirements: Full sun to part shade Bloom Time: Mid spring (Mid–Late April) Pest Resistance: Deer/rodent resistant



Narcissus 'Golden Ducat'

An early/mid-spring standout, this opulent double daffodil adds bold, golden texture, ideal for mass plantings and fresh bouquets.

Height: ~16"

Flower Color/Form: Large, double golden-yellow blooms resembling peonies

Light Requirements: Full sun to part shade Bloom Time: Mid spring (Early–Mid April) Pest Resistance: Deer/rodent resistant

Daffodils



Narcissus 'White Ice Follies'

A spring staple with a soft, creamy elegance—ideal for combining with bold-colored flowers or planting in groups for a serene spring carpet.

Height: 14-16"

Flower Color/Form: White to creamy petals with a pale golden center

Light Requirements: Full sun to light shade

Bloom Time: Early to mid spring (Late March–Mid April)

Pest Resistance: Deer/rodent resistant



Narcissus 'Shade Tolerant' Variety Blend

Brightens shady corners with staggered blooms; naturalizes beautifully while adding multi-season interest.

Height: 12-18"

Flower Color/Form: Variety of pastel yellows, creams, and pinks

Light Requirements: Full sun to full shade Bloom Time: Early to late spring (March–April)

Pest Resistance: Deer/rodent resistant



Narcissus 'White' Variety Blend

A refined, fragrant mix of whites perfect for woodland settings, containers, or alongside darker foliage for a crisp spring statement.

Height: ~14-16"

Flower Color/Form: Blend of 'Obdam', 'Ice Follies', and 'Thalia'

Light Requirements: Full sun to part shade

Bloom Time: Early to mid spring (Late March-April)

Pest Resistance: Deer/rodent resistant

Daffodil Tips

Your daffodils will return year after year with very little care! Once they've finished blooming, you can remove the spent flowers if you'd like, but let the leaves stay put until they've completely died back. This helps the bulbs recharge for next season.

Alliums



Allium ampeloprasum 'Ping Pong'

A playful, long-blooming allium with durable, spherical blooms that transition from pink to white. Great for pollinators and as an architectural focal point.

Height: 20"

Flower Color/Form: Blooms start pink, aging to bright white globes

Light Requirements: Full sun

Bloom Time: Late spring to early summer (May–June)
Pest Resistance: Deer/rodent resistant, attracts pollinators



Allium 'Gladiator'

An imposing spring bloomer, Gladiator delivers towering purple balls that forge dramatic structure and attract pollinators in early-season gardens.

Height: ~30-36"

Flower Color/Form: Rich purple globes

Light Requirements: Full sun

Bloom Time: Late spring (Late May–Early June)

Pest Resistance: Deer/rodent resistant, attracts pollinators



Allium aflatunense 'Purple Sensation'

A garden classic—Purple Sensation provides bold, spherical purple blooms that elicit visual drama and floral interest year after year.

Height: ~18-20"

Flower Color/Form: Large, double golden-yellow blooms resembling peonies

Light Requirements: Full sun

Bloom Time: Mid spring (Mid–Late May)

Pest Resistance: Deer/rodent resistant, attracts pollinators



Allium sphaerocephalon 'Drumstick'

Compact yet bold, Drumstick Allium offers dramatic, elongated flower clusters that fade elegantly with age, giving subtle interest.

Height: ~12"

Flower Color/Form: Rich deep purple, almost egg-shaped heads

Light Requirements: Full sun

Bloom Time: Early to midsummer (June–July)

Pest Resistance: Deer/rodent resistant, attracts pollinators

Hyacinths



Hyacinth 'Blue and White Blend'

Adds fragrance and vertical texture in early spring; lovely with daffodils and tulips.

Height: ~8-12"

Flower Color/Form: Purple, pink, white clusters

Light Requirements: Full sun

Bloom Time: Late spring (Late May–Early June)

Pest Resistance: Deer/rodent resistant, attracts pollinators



Hyacinth 'Royal Trio Blend'

A regal mix bringing fragrance and mid-spring charm to beds and borders.

Height: ~8-12"

Flower Color/Form: Varied blue to white clusters in dense flowery spikes

Light Requirements: Full sun to part shade

Bloom Time: Late spring to early summer (May–June)
Pest Resistance: Deer/rodent resistant, attracts pollinators

Crocus



Crocus Variety Blend

Crocus mixes bring early-season cheer in a flurry of pastel purples, whites, and yellows and are perfect for naturalizing lawns and garden beds.

Height: ~4-6"

Flower Color/Form: Open goblet-shaped spring blooms

Light Requirements: Full sun

Bloom Time: Very early spring (Mid–Late March)

Pest Resistance: Not deer/rodent resistant, attracts pollinators
