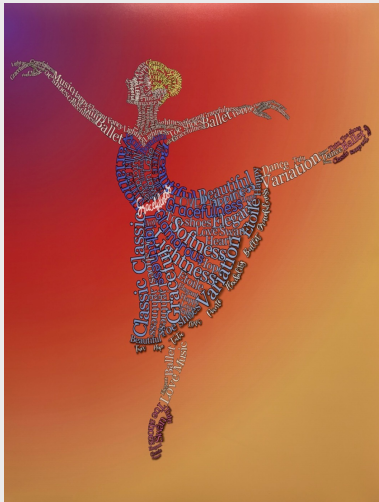

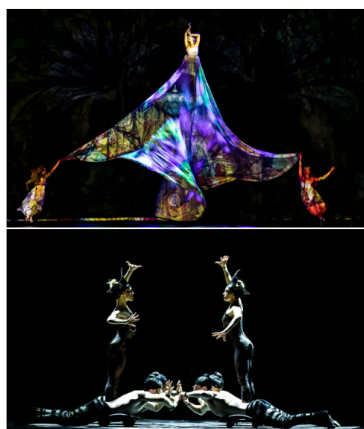


Dance Works Field Trips Galore Inspire!
